Pregame Notes

- **Battlers Begin Salvatore Dewalt Era:** After finishing with a 9-2 record in his final year of coaching, Dennis Creehan stepped down as head coach of the Battlers following the 2016 season. Sal Dewalt, who has spent the past three seasons as the Offensive Line Coach, was named head coach prior to spring practices in March.
- **New Look 2017:** AB graduated 39 seniors in 2016 including 15 starters from the G-MAC Championship team. The Battlers have a lot of young faces on both sides of the ball that will look to see time on the field in 2017. Returning on offense includes QB Connor McWilliams, who played in four games in 2016 before injuring himself for the season in a loss to Fairmont State. On the offensive line, AB returns William Iacobucci and Donovan McNellis while out wide, the Battlers return wideouts A.J. Cummings and Zack Lake. On defense, Brandon Lavern returns up front while Paul Gabel comes back to play linebacker for his final season. In the back, Joseph Shelton started last season at corner and will play his senior season in 2017.
- **G-MAC Expands to 8 For Football:** This past summer, Findlay, Hillsdale, Lake Erie, Ohio Dominican, and Walsh joined the G-MAC to make up the eight-team football conference. AB will play seven conference games in 2017. In 2018, the G-MAC announced the addition of Tiffin University who will become the 14th G-MAC institution and becomes the 9th football-playing member. In the preseason coaches rankings, Ohio Dominican was ranked just outside of the Top-25 as the sixth team receiving votes at 31. The Panthers come to Philippi on October 21st.
- **Cummings, Lake Look to Have Breakout Seasons:** A year ago, Zack Lake and A.J. Cummings emerged as two of the top targets on offense. Lake finished with four TD grabs on the year while Lake finished with three. They finished second and third respectively in receiving yards after Cooper Schroeder led the team and is the career-leader in receiving. The Battlers have a number of other weapons outside as Oran Davis and Jermaine Wynn are both expected to see significant time on the field in their first seasons while Braxton Johnson rejoins the Battlers after originally playing for AB in 2013 and 2014. In 2014, Johnson finished with five TD receptions on 307 yards receiving. Johnson has the longest TD reception in AB history when he caught a 57-yard pass from Wilson Vaughn against Cumberland in 2013.
- **Scouting Saginaw Valley State:** The Cardinals finished the 2016 season with a 5-5 overall record. SVSU nearly knocked off Top-5 opponent Grand Valley State but the Cardinals fell in double-OT 62-56. SVSU returns both QB's Jacob LeClair and Ryan Conklin who played six games each. Conklin threw eight TD's including three against Grand Valley. Tommy Scott Jr. will return in the backfield after rushing for over 300 yards in his freshman year while the Cardinals lost their top three receivers who combined to catch 70% of the passes.

Meet the Head Coach: Salvatore Dewalt

Salvatore Dewalt Head Football Coach

Salvatore Dewalt was named the head coach of the Alderson Broaddus football team in March, 2017, after spending the past three seasons on staff as the Offensive Line Coach and Director of Football Operations.

During his first three seasons on staff Dewalt has helped the Battler offense average 33 points, 164 rushing yards and 243 passing yards per game. Dewalt's offensive line also helped paved the way for running back Brandon Jones who was named second-team All-American in 2014.

Prior to his time at AB Dewalt spent three seasons as the Offensive Line Coach and Run Game Coordinator at Randolph-Macon College. RMC averaged 33 points and 212 yards per game on the ground in Dewalt's tenure. Dewalt also tutored six All-Conference selections along the offensive line. Running back Will McGhee broke the school record for rushing in 2013 with 1,676 yards. While at RMC Dewalt was responsible for the punt team which finished first nationally in return yards allowed in 2013 with 1.38 yards per return.

Prior to his time with Randolph-Macon, Dewalt spent two seasons at Lehigh University as the Assistant Offensive Line Coach. In 2010 Lehigh won the Patriot League Championship and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. Following the 2010 season offensive tackle Will Rackley was drafted in the third round of the NFL Draft.

Dewalt started his career as the offensive line coach at Moravian College for three seasons where he tutored six All-Conference selections.

Dewalt played on the offensive line at Moravian serving as a team captain for two seasons. He played in 43 games on the offensive line including 32 starts to close out his career. Dewalt was a two-time first-team All-Conference selection while also earning two first-team All-Region honors and was an honorable mention All-American in 2005.

Dewalt earned a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from Moravian College in 2006.

He resides in Philippi, W.Va. with his wife Kristina, the Director of AB Spirit Squads, and their son Alexander.

In the 4th, Brandon Jones sealed the win with a 27-yard TD run with 11:52 remaining.
- Three weeks later on September 28th, 2013, AB trailed the University of Virginia-Lynchburg 14-3. Wesley Nesmith connected with Preston Bailey for a 17-yard touchdown with 12:04 remaining to cut the lead to 14-9. With 40 seconds remaining in the game, Nesmith scampered into the endzone for a nine-yard TD to win the game 17-14 for the Battlers.
- On September 18th, 2015, AB trailed Lincoln University 21-0 in just the opening 6:08 of action. The Battlers stormed back with a pair of TD's and a field goal from Jordan Butler to the lead to 21-17 at the half. Following a Lincoln field goal in the third to make it 24-17, Butler connected on a 30-yard field goal to make it 24-20 after three. In the fourth, the Battlers forced a safety with 6:03 left to make it 24-22 and with 4:26 left, Brehon Daniels scored from 13 yards out to win the game 28-24 for AB.
- Following AB's 53-6 win on homecoming against Central International, the Battlers traveled south to Fort Valley, Georgia to face Fort Valley State. Trailing 20-7 with 5:01 remaining in the game, Tory Lee caught a 11-yard TD pass from Vaughn to cut the lead to 20-14. After a defensive stop, AB got the ball back and Dillon Schoolcraft caught the game-winning touchdown from Vaughn with 30 seconds to make it 21-20. The Battlers added one more score with seven seconds left when Michael James returned an interception 57 yards for the 27-20 victory.
- On October 8th, 2016, AB trailed Malone 16-14 with 14:53 to go in the game. The Battlers scored three fourth-quarter touchdowns including two TD passes to A.J. Cummings in route to the comeback victory and the first conference victory in football history.
