Pregame Notes

- **Battlers Drop Road Contest at Quincy:** A week ago, the Battlers dropped their first road contest of the year, 50-21, at Quincy. QB Connor McWilliams passed for 257 and a touchdown in the loss.
- **Lake Becomes First WR Over 100 Yards Since 2015:** Zack Lake caught 5 passes for 112 yards against Quincy. That was the first time an AB receiver finished with more than 100 yards in a game since Cooper Schroeder finished with 127 yards in a win against Kentucky Wesleyan in 2015. On the season, Lake has 176 yards receiving on nine catches.
- **Wynn Continues Hot Start:** Freshman wide receiver Jermaine Wynn had another strong game in his second-career contest. Wynn finished with 6 catches for 92 yards. He leads the team with 11 catches on the year for 172 yards and a pair of touchdowns.
- **Non-Conference Slate:** AB will play two more non-conference games before starting G-MAC play. After the game against Lincoln, AB will host rival Glenville State College on Saturday September 23rd at noon for the I-79 Barrel Classic. In the first two years of the rivalry, GSC won at AB in 2015 before the Battlers returned the favor in 2016 with a 19-7 road victory in Glenville.
- **History Against Lincoln:** The Battlers faced the Lions once in their four-year history when the two teams met in 2015 at Lincoln. In that contest, the Battlers erased a 21-0 first-quarter deficit before coming back to defeat the Lions 28-24. Lincoln jumped out to a 21-0 lead just six minutes into the game before AB was forced to play from behind. Tight End Cooper Schroeder caught a pair of first-half TD's in the win and then Jordan Butler added a field goal to cut the lead to 21-17 at the half. In the second half, the teams traded field goals before AB scored two points on a safety with 6:03 to play to cut the lead to 24-22 and then with just over four minutes to play, Brehon Daniels won the game with a 13-yard touchdown run for the 28-24 win.
- **Scouting the Lions:** In the opening two games of the season, Lincoln fell at Cheyney 56-28 and Lincoln U of Missouri 49-19. Cheyney took a 56-0 lead into the half in the opener before holding on for the win. In the second game, Lincoln U of Missouri compiled 442 total yards of offense, including 265 on the ground, in route to the victory over the Lions. Vincent Espinoza has passed for seven touchdowns on the season with nearly 500 passing yards in the two contests. Out wide, Andre Price leads the receivers with nine catches for 178 yards and two scores while RB Rameses Owens has 104 yards on the ground with two scores in a pair of contests.

Meet the Head Coach: Salvatore Dewalt

Salvatore Dewalt Head Football Coach

Salvatore Dewalt was named the head coach of the Alderson Broaddus football team in March, 2017, after spending the past three seasons on staff as the Offensive Line Coach and Director of Football Operations.

During his first three seasons on staff Dewalt has helped the Battler offense average 33 points, 164 rushing yards and 243 passing yards per game. Dewalt's offensive line also helped paved the way for running back Brandon Jones who was named second-team All-American in 2014.

Prior to his time at AB Dewalt spent three seasons as the Offensive Line Coach and Run Game Coordinator at Randolph-Macon College. RMC averaged 33 points and 212 yards per game on the ground in Dewalt's tenure. Dewalt also tutored six All-Conference selections along the offensive line. Running back Will McGhee broke the school record for rushing in 2013 with 1,676 yards. While at RMC Dewalt was responsible for the punt team which finished first nationally in return yards allowed in 2013 with 1.38 yards per return.

Prior to his time with Randolph-Macon, Dewalt spent two seasons at Lehigh University as the Assistant Offensive Line Coach. In 2010 Lehigh won the Patriot League Championship and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. Following the 2010 season offensive tackle Will Rackley was drafted in the third round of the NFL Draft.

Dewalt started his career as the offensive line coach at Moravian College for three seasons where he tutored six All-Conference selections.

Dewalt played on the offensive line at Moravian serving as a team captain for two seasons. He played in 43 games on the offensive line including 32 starts to close out his career. Dewalt was a two-time first-team All-Conference selection while also earning two first-team All-Region honors and was an honorable mention All-American in 2005.

Dewalt earned a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from Moravian College in 2006.

He resides in Philippi, W.Va. with his wife Kristina, the Director of AB Spirit Squads, and their son Alexander.

Through a partnership with Stretch Internet, the Great Midwest Digital Network is being launched in time for the 2017-18 academic year as the league's primary video streaming platform.

All 13 member institutions and the conference office will stream video, audio and select live stats, through customized portals that feature home and away contests for various sports.

Stretch will develop custom Great Midwest apps on the Roku, Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV and Android TV platforms.

These apps will provide fans a seamless way to access content directly on their TVs – with no need to “relay” or “cast” the stream from tablets, phones or desktop computers. Users can access the content simply by searching for “Great Midwest” on the app interfaces on any of the compatible platforms, and then downloading the free Great Midwest Digital Network app.

Using the professionally-designed, intuitive interface, fans can easily view a conference-wide schedule of live, upcoming and on-demand broadcasts – or filter by a specific school.

In the 4th, Brandon Jones sealed the win with a 27-yard TD run with 11:52 remaining.
- Three weeks later on September 28th, 2013, AB trailed the University of Virginia-Lynchburg 14-3. Wesley Nesmith connected with Preston Bailey for a 17-yard touchdown with 12:04 remaining to cut the lead to 14-9. With 40 seconds remaining in the game, Nesmith scampered into the endzone for a nine-yard TD to win the game 17-14 for the Battlers.
- On September 18th, 2015, AB trailed Lincoln University 21-0 in just the opening 6:08 of action. The Battlers stormed back with a pair of TD's and a field goal from Jordan Butler to the lead to 21-17 at the half.
