Pregame Notes

- Last weekend, freshman running back Jamil-Collison-Cofie rushed for 91 yards and a career-high three touchdowns in a 47-42 loss to Glenville State. Collison-Cofie now has more than 300 yards rushing on the season and five touchdowns.
- Quarterback Connor McWilliams passed for 247 yards and a touchdown last weekend. He now has over 1,000 yards passing in four games with seven touchdowns.
- Jermaine Wynn caught four passes for 72 yards and a touchdown against GSC. Wynn is the leading receiver for the Battlers with 15 catches for 244 yards and three touchdowns.
- A.J. Cummings added three catches last time out and is the second-leading receiver for AB. The junior has tallied 13 catches for 146 yards and a score. Six different Battler receivers have caught a TD pass in 2017.
- On defense, junior Quade Raley had another strong performance on Saturday. He finished with nine tackles for the second game in a row and added one and a half tackles for loss. He leads the team with 22 tackles.
- Freshman D.J. Opsatnik finished 6-of-6 on extra-points last week. He is perfect on the season at 16-for-16 and has made three of his six field-goal attempts with a long of 39.
- Grant Noon had another strong performance against the Pioneers. He currently has an average of 42.2 yards per punt with a long of 59. He has three over 50 yards, four inside the 20, and just two touchbacks in 17 punts. His 42.2 yards per punt ranks 13th in NCAA Division II.
- Lake Erie comes into Saturday's game with an 0-4 record on the season. The Storm are averaging five points per game this season.
- Quarterbacks James Moore and Javarian Smith have combined to throw for 614 yards passing and four interceptions. Moore is expected to get the start on Saturday.
- Antwan Harris leads the team with 180 rushing yards and a touchdown. Out wide, Mitch Tilley has 12 receptions for 78 yards as sophomore Josh Collins has 11 catches for 82 yards.
- Saturday's matchup will be the first between the two schools. It will be AB's first conference game of the 2017 season.

Meet the Head Coach: Salvatore Dewalt

Salvatore Dewalt Head Football Coach

Salvatore Dewalt was named the head coach of the Alderson Broaddus football team in March, 2017, after spending the past three seasons on staff as the Offensive Line Coach and Director of Football Operations.

During his first three seasons on staff Dewalt has helped the Battler offense average 33 points, 164 rushing yards and 243 passing yards per game. Dewalt's offensive line also helped paved the way for running back Brandon Jones who was named second-team All-American in 2014.

Prior to his time at AB Dewalt spent three seasons as the Offensive Line Coach and Run Game Coordinator at Randolph-Macon College. RMC averaged 33 points and 212 yards per game on the ground in Dewalt's tenure. Dewalt also tutored six All-Conference selections along the offensive line. Running back Will McGhee broke the school record for rushing in 2013 with 1,676 yards. While at RMC Dewalt was responsible for the punt team which finished first nationally in return yards allowed in 2013 with 1.38 yards per return.

Prior to his time with Randolph-Macon, Dewalt spent two seasons at Lehigh University as the Assistant Offensive Line Coach. In 2010 Lehigh won the Patriot League Championship and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. Following the 2010 season offensive tackle Will Rackley was drafted in the third round of the NFL Draft.

Dewalt started his career as the offensive line coach at Moravian College for three seasons where he tutored six All-Conference selections.

Dewalt played on the offensive line at Moravian serving as a team captain for two seasons. He played in 43 games on the offensive line including 32 starts to close out his career. Dewalt was a two-time first-team All-Conference selection while also earning two first-team All-Region honors and was an honorable mention All-American in 2005.

Dewalt earned a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from Moravian College in 2006.

He resides in Philippi, W.Va. with his wife Kristina, the Director of AB Spirit Squads, and their son Alexander.

Through a partnership with Stretch Internet, the Great Midwest Digital Network is being launched in time for the 2017-18 academic year as the league's primary video streaming platform.

All 13 member institutions and the conference office will stream video, audio and select live stats, through customized portals that feature home and away contests for various sports.

Stretch will develop custom Great Midwest apps on the Roku, Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV and Android TV platforms.

These apps will provide fans a seamless way to access content directly on their TVs – with no need to “relay” or “cast” the stream from tablets, phones or desktop computers. Users can access the content simply by searching for “Great Midwest” on the app interfaces on any of the compatible platforms, and then downloading the free Great Midwest Digital Network app.

Using the professionally-designed, intuitive interface, fans can easily view a conference-wide schedule of live, upcoming and on-demand broadcasts – or filter by a specific school.
