Pregame Notes

- The Battlers will look to end their two-game slide with their G-MAC home opener on Saturday against Malone. Last weekend, the Battlers fell at Lake Erie College 16-15.
- Quarterbacks Connor McWilliams and Zach Chandler each saw action a week ago.
 McWilliams finished with 115 yards passing and a touchdown while Chandler passed for 27 yards but rushed for 57 yards on 11 carries.
- Jamil-Collison-Cofie rushed for 127 yards on 19 carries for his second game over 100 yards this season. He has now rushed for 435 yards on 60 carries with six touchdowns. He ranks second in the G-MAC in rushing and tied for third in touchdowns.
- Out wide, redshirt freshman wide receiver Jermaine Wynn caught three passes for 56 yards and a touchdown. He has an even 300-yards receiving in 2017 and leads the team with four touchdown receptions.
- Punter Grant Noon had another strong game on Saturday. The senior ranks inside the Top-20 nationally in punting at 41.7 yards per game and is first in the G-MAC. He has four punts over 50 yards with a long of 59.
- Defensively, William Bailey recorded a career-high 15 tackles with a half-tackle for loss. Quade Raley had another strong performance with 10 tackles, four tackles for loss, and two and a half sacks.
- At linebacker, Paul Gabel tallied nine tackles against Lake Erie with four tackles for loss, one sack, and one pass break-up. On the season, Gabel has 26 tackles.
- In the series history, each team has a victory on the opponent's turf. In 2013, the Pioneers topped the Battlers 59-42 before AB came back and defeated Malone 35-16 in Canton last season. Saturday will be the third meeting between the two schools.

Meet the Head Coach: Salvatore Dewalt



Salvatore Dewalt Head Football Coach

Salvatore Dewalt was named the head coach of the Alderson Broaddus football team in March, 2017, after spending the past three seasons on staff as the Offensive Line Coach and Director of Football Operations.

During his first three seasons on staff Dewalt has helped the Battler offense average 33 points, 164 rushing yards and 243 passing yards per game. Dewalt's offensive line also helped paved the way for running back Brandon Jones who was named second-team All-American in 2014.

Prior to his time at AB Dewalt spent three seasons as the Offensive Line Coach and Run Game Coordinator at Randolph-Macon College. RMC averaged 33 points and 212 yards per game on the ground in Dewalt's tenure. Dewalt also tutored six All-Conference selections along the offensive line. Running back Will McGhee broke the school record for rushing in 2013 with 1,676 yards. While at RMC Dewalt was responsible for the punt team which finished first nationally in return yards allowed in 2013 with 1.38 yards per return.

Prior to his time with Randolph-Macon, Dewalt spent two seasons at Lehigh University as the Assistant Offensive Line Coach. In 2010 Lehigh won the Patriot League Championship and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. Following the 2010 season offensive tackle Will Rackley was drafted in the third round of the NFL Draft.

Dewalt started his career as the offensive line coach at Moravian College for three seasons where he tutored six All-Conference selections.

Dewalt played on the offensive line at Moravian serving as a team captain for two seasons. He played in 43 games on the offensive line including 32 starts to close out his career. Dewalt was a two-time first-team All-Conference selection while also earning two first-team All-Region honors and was an honorable mention All-American in 2005.

Dewalt earned a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from Moravian College in 2006.

He resides in Philippi, W.Va. with his wife Kristina, the Director of AB Spirit Squads, and their son Alexander.
