Last Time Out

Columbus, Ohio – It had been 15 years since the Findlay Oilers last played for a conference title in football. In that game, the Orange and Black went on the road and lost to a quality opponent. On Saturday, Nov. 11 in Columbus, that story played out again. Findlay traveled to Ohio Dominican University to take on the Panthers with the Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) Championship on the line and the Oilers, ranked no. 21 in the country and fourth in Super Region One, fell short by a score of 49-24.

The first points of the game came with four-and-a-half minutes left in the first quarter when junior Jacob Allton, who had been kicking extra points for the Oilers in their previous three contests, knocked in a 22-yard field goal to put Findlay ahead 3-0.

Less than three minutes later, ODU's Grant Russell found Cory Contini in the end zone to give the home team their first lead. That duo would prove to be a difference maker as the game progressed.

Trailing 7-3 through the first quarter, Findlay took the lead back with ten minutes to play in the half on a three-yard touchdown run by senior Daouda Sylla. However, a 72-yard touchdown from Russell to Contini and later a 29-yard touchdown from Russell to David Turner would give the Panthers a daunting 21-10 lead at the half.

The Panthers picked up the pace even more in the second half of play, outscoring Findlay 28-14 after halftime.

The Oilers big highlight of the half came at the end of the third quarter when junior kickoff returner Jacob Hill cut through the Panthers' kick coverage for a 93-yard kick return touchdown, his second of the season.

Findlay came in scoring 49.9 points per game, second-highest in the country, but the Panthers found the answer with their third-down defense, holding the Oilers to just 4-of-15 while converting on 6-of-12 on third down themselves.

The newly minted G-MAC champs put up 516 yards of total offense while holding Findlay, ranked third in the country in total offense at 525 yards per game, to just 359 yards, their lowest in any league game this season.

Junior quarterback Rhys Gervais finished the game 21-of-38 for 212 yards. He threw one interception and for the first time since Sep. 17, 2016 against Ashland, 18 games ago, did not throw a touchdown pass.

Senior Daouda Sylla had his seventh 100+ yard rushing performance of the season, picking up 134 yards on 29 carries. He scored a pair of touchdowns in the loss.

Junior preseason all-American Jason Moore made eight catches for 110 yards, the 15th time in his career that he has eclipsed the 100-yard mark. Senior Darnell Fields made a career-high four catches for 43 yards and junior Jacob Allton made three catches for 25 yards.

The Oilers' leading tackler was junior Francis Cutchember who finished with eight stops on the day. Teammates Chiebuka Chukwuneke, Terrence Smith, Grant Kinsinger, and Kyle Gibson each finished with six tackles. Gibson, a true freshman, ended the game with a half-sack and a pass breakup to his credit while Chukwuneke tallied an interception.

Shepherd University Rams

There haven't been many programs in the country with as much recent success as Shepherd University. The Rams have a record of 95-21 (.819) in the last ten seasons and have qualified for the DII National Playoffs in five of the previous six seasons. In 2017, they were one of just eight Division II teams to finish the year undefeated.

Coached by Monte Carter, the 2017 MEC Coach of the Year, the Shepherd Rams have been fueled all season by one of the best offenses in the country. The Rams rank second in the country in total offense (527.4 ypg), second in scoring offense (48.5 ppg), fifth in passing offense (333.9 ypg), and fifth in passing efficiency (172.9).

With all that success on offense, the Rams' defense ranked 70th in the country in scoring defense at 25.6 ppg. However, with 8.5 tackles-for-loss per game (15th in country), 3.3 sacks per game (5th in country), and just 86.2 rushing yards per game allowed (9th in country), Shepherd can stall drives in a hurry.

Senior quarterback Connor Jessop, the MEC Offensive Player of the Year and potential Harlon Hill candidate this season, is the unquestioned leader on offense. Jessop is the nation's active leader in passing efficiency with a career QBR of 184.3. He ranks second in the country this season with 38 touchdown passes, second in passing yards per game (330), fourth in passing yards (3,300), and is responsible for more points than any player in the nation this season (270).

His favorite target is junior wide receiver Ryan Feiss, a first team all-MEC selection who has 1,326 receiving yards and eight touchdowns this season. His receiving yards are third-most in the country this season while his receiving yards per game of 132.6 rank second.

When the ball isn't going to Feiss through the air, senior Jabre Lolley, also a first team all-MEC performer, has been a force out of the backfield. Lolley has picked up 1,085 yards on the ground this year at 108.5 yards per game. He is picking up 6.5 yards per carry and has scored 15 touchdowns on the ground.

On defense, senior Myles Humphrey leads the Rams and was recently named MEC Defensive Player of the Year. He led the MEC with 11 solo sacks and is second on the DII active list with 38.5 sacks in his career, a school record. He is also second among active DII players with nine forced fumbles in his career.

Behind Humphrey is a trio of first team all-MEC performers including linebacker James Gupton and defensive backs Tre Anderson and DeJuan Neal. Gupton has 71 tackles, 13.5 tackles-for-loss, and 5.0 sacks this season while Anderson and Neal have combined for five interceptions, six pass breakups, and 54 tackles.

Wise, Va. - Senior quarterback Connor Jessop (Ashburn, Va./Broad Run/Virginia Tech) completed 25-of-45 passes for 386 yards and four touchdowns and senior running back Jabre Lolley (Wilmington, Del./St. Mark's) rushed 13 times for 99 yards and three touchdowns to lead Shepherd University (10-0, 10-0 MEC) to a 63-35 win over UVa-Wise (5-6, 4-6 MEC) in MEC football action at UVa-Wise on Saturday.

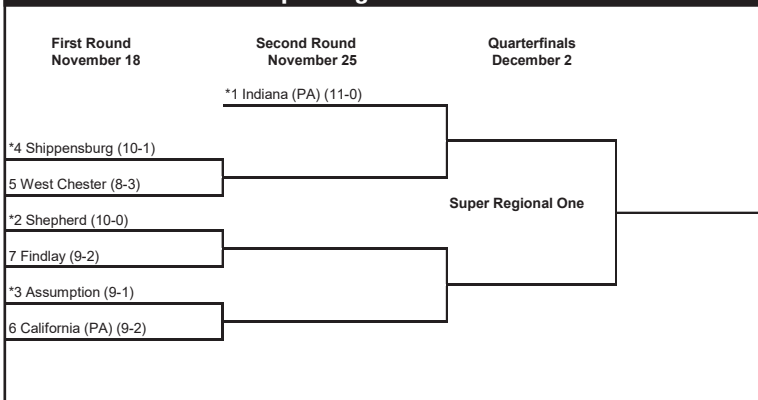

Findlay Record Watch

Rhys Gervais: Gervais is rewriting the record books, both season and career. In his time as the Oilers signal-caller, the Puyallup, Wash. native has completed 600-of-941 passes for 8,046 yards and 79 touchdowns, all of which are career records at Findlay.

He owns the top two passing seasons as well with 2,835 yards in 2016 and a record 3,353 passing yards in 2015 making him the first quarterback in Findlay Oilers history to have multiple seasons with multiple 2,300+ seasons. The only other QB to come close is Clay Belton who threw for 2,039 yards in 2010 and 2,329 yards in 2011. Gervais is also the only QB to have multiple seasons with 20+ touchdowns.

Along with season and career records, Gervais has set multiple single-game records, as well. Since coming to Findlay, Gervais has had three games in which he has thrown five touchdown passes which is tied for the most in a game in Findlay history. The only other player to have five TDs in a game was Bo Hurley who did so against Taylor University in 1997.

Gervais has also attempted and completed more passes in a game than anyone else in Findlay history when he complete 34-of-59 passes last season against Ohio Dominican. His 507 passing yards against Tiffin in 2015 are also a Findlay record.

On Oct. 20 against Kentucky Wesleyan, Gervais passed Bo Hurely as Findlay's all-time total offense leader. Gervais currently is responsible for 8,166 yards.

Jason Moore: In 2016, the Moore had one of the best seasons a wide receiver has had at Findlay. He caught 71 balls (T3 in a season at UF) for a school record 1,115 yards and 15 touchdowns, also a school record. Because of his incredible succes last season, he is now approaching some career records as well.

In his career, Moore has 164 career receptions, second all-time at Findlay. He needs 13 to catch Lloyd Henry (2011-14) at 177, the all-time record. The Oberlin, OH native has caught 35 touchdown passes in his career, first all-time at Findlay.

Moore's 13 touchdown catches this season are tied for third-most in a season at UF.

Against Alderson Broaddus on Nov. 4, 2017, Moore also became Findlay's all-time leader in receiving yards in a career, passing Lloyd Henry who had 2,410 in his career (2011-14). Moore currently has 2,475 receiving yards.

Findlay Offense: As a team, Findlay has scored 523 points, second-most all time at Findlay. The Oilers need 44 points to catch the highest scoring team in history at UF (1997 | 567 points).

Notes

Oilers in Week 12: Findlay has played a twelfth game in a season on seven occasions. The Oilers are 5-2 in those games.

National Ranking: After being ranked as high as #21 this season, the Oilers have fallen out of the national rankings after their defeat in the conference championship.

Historic Season: With a 9-2 record this season, the 2017 squad continues its best season in the Rob Keys era. The nine wins are the most since a nine-win season in 2002. The Oilers have not started a season 9-1 or 10-0 since 2002 and now have had two such seasons since the year 2000 (2002 / 2017).

Streak: The Oilers eight-game winning streak was the longest in the NCAA Division II era of Findlay football and is the first to happen at Findlay since 1997 when Dick Strahm coached the Oilers to a perfect 14-0 season and captured an NAIA National Championship.

60-point games: Findlay has scored 60+ points in four games this year, the most 60+ point games in a season in school history. With all the high scoring games, Findlay owns the top four scoring games in Great Midwest history.

300-yard rushing games: The Oilers have five games this year with 300+ yards rushing, the first time that has happened since 2013.

The Total Package: The Oilers are scoring 47.5 points per game (third in the country) and are allowing just 17.1 points per game (18th in the country).

Defensive Dominance: In 2015, the Oilers' defense was giving up 468.3 yards per game, second-to-last in the GLIAC, ahead of only Lake Erie who gave up 533.5. In 2016, Findlay turned up the pressure on defense, limiting opponents to 386.3 yards per game, eighth in the GLIAC. That improvement showed on the scoreboard as their scoring defense improved from 37.2 ppg to 26.0 ppg allowed.

This season, that defense has been taken to a new level. Findlay's defense is allowing just 17.1 points per game and gets off the field in a hurry, allowing opponents to have a time of possession of just under 27 minutes per game, second in the region and 12th in the country. Findlay has been lights out in the secondary where the self-titled 'Air Marshals' are helping lead the way for a defense that has intercepted 16 passes, 13th in the country, and has scored five defensive touchdowns, seventh in the country.

Findlay's turnover margin of +1.55 per game is second in the country.

G-MAC Player of the Week: The Oilers have won two Offensive Player of the Week and four Defensive Player of the Week awards from the conference this season.

Daouda Sylla won the award in Week 1 (28 carries | 183 yards | 3 TD) and Jason Moore won in Week 2 (9 catches | 125 yards | 3 TD).

In Week 4, Johnny Hopkins snagged his first Great Midwest Defensive Player of the Week award when he picked up six tackles, three tackles-for-loss, and two sacks. Another Defensive Player of the Week award came in a Week 6 win over Hillsdale as Isaac Miles earned the award highlighted by a fumble recovery that led to the first Oilers touchdown of the day. In Week 8, senior Aaron Ivory earned the award on defense with four tackles and a pick-six, his third of the year. In Week 10, sophomore Tyler Lee earned the award, intercepting two passes including one for a touchdown.

Lindy's Preseason All-Americans: Junior wide receiver Jason Moore and senior offensive lineman Andrew Alten were named preseason all-Americans by Lindy's Sports in 2017. Alten was listed on first team while Moore earned second team honors. They were the only players on the list that represented the Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

Notes

New Faces: Saturday's game will be the fifth time this season that Findlay has faced an opponent for the first time. The Oilers are 4-0 in such games this season, winning those games by an average of 48.8 points per game.

300-Yard Passing Games: Junior quarterback Rhys Gervais holds the University of Findlay record for 300-yard passing games in a career with 11. He had five such games in 2015 and added four more a season ago. The previous record for 300-yard games in a career was six.

His lone 300-yard performance this season came against Hillsdale where, coming off two inactive weeks due to injury, Gervais lit up the Chargers for 332 yards.

Air Raid: Gervais has been one of the best quarterbacks in the region in the last two seasons. In 2015 he finished atop the GLIAC in passing yards per game (304.8), the ninth-best total in the country that year. His passer rating of 163.5 was fourth in the country. In 2016, Gervais was second in the GLIAC in passing yards per game (257.7).

So far, Gervais' accuracy has been the big improvement as he is completing passes at 70.6%, his highest to date. He is also throwing less interceptions, just four this year compared to 12 at this point last season. This season Gervais has a passer rating of 188.9. If that continues, it would be his highest since taking over the quarterbacking duties at Findlay.

A Positive Transition: Daouda Sylla, who spent his first two years at Findlay as a linebacker, has made the transition to running back flawlessly. In 20 games as a tailback, Sylla has rushed for 1,724 yards (86.2 ypg) and 20 touchdowns.

1,000-yard rusher: In the Oct. 20 win over Kentucky Wesleyan, Daouda Sylla eclipsed the 1,000 yard mark for the season becoming the 21st player in Findlay history to have a 1,000 season. Allen Smith had a pair of 1,000 yard seasons (1964, '65) while Nelson Bolden (1978, '79, '80) and Montrae Williams (2009, '10, '11) did so three times.

Postseason Play: Despite falling in their conference championship game, the Oilers qualified for their first ever NCAA Division II Playoffs, earning the no. 7 seed in Super Region One. Findlay has not played a playoff game since Dec. 20, 1997 when they defeated Willamette to win the NAIA National Championship with a perfect 14-0 record.

Top-25 Challenge: The Oilers have played 36 games against NCAA Top-25 teams. In those games, Findlay has a 4-32 record.

Against Top-5 Teams: Findlay has played ten games against an NCAA Top-10 team. The Oilers are 0-10 in those games, including a 48-27 loss to #2 Ferris St. earlier this year.

High Scoring Affair: Findlay's 70 points scored against Alderson Broaddus on Nov. 4 was one of just 19 games in the country this year in which a team scored at least 70 points. Bowie St, the nation's top scoring team at more than 56 points per game, scored at least 76 points on three occasions and have the most points in a game this year (86 against Lincoln (PA) on Oct. 28).
