FINDLAY FOOTBALL WEEK 10 GAME NOTES




The Game: In their final regular season home game of the year, the Oilers will play host to the 2016 Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) Champion, Alderson Broaddus Battlers. The game will begin at 1:00pm with Senior Day festivities prior to kick off.

The Matchup

The last time the Oilers played a home game as a ranked team was in September of 2003. That changes this Saturday with Alderson Broaddus coming to town on Findlay's senior day. The Battlers have never played a ranked opponent in their nearly five full seasons as a program (became an official sport in 2013).

Findlay has been throttling conference opponents, outscoring Great Midwest teams by 45 points per game. The Oilers have scored 429 points this year, more points than the three lowest scoring teams in the league combined and 146 points more than the second-highest scoring team in the league. The 429 points are also a new league record.

WEEK 10 GAME NOTES



Canton, Ohio – The University of Findlay football team improved on their longest win streak since 1997 with yet another convincing win on Thursday, October 26. The Oilers, which are ranked #22 in the nation, took down the Malone Pioneers by a score of 49-0 to improve to 8-1 overall and a perfect 5-0 in Great Midwest Athletic Conference (GMAC) play. It was Findlay's first game as a top-25 team since 2014 and the first time since 2004 that the Orange and Black have had at least two shutouts in a season. In five games against the Great Midwest, Findlay is putting up 51.6 points per game, outscoring opponents 258-33.

The Oilers showed why they made the jump into the national poll, dominating the game in every way. Coming into the game, Findlay ranked in the top-ten in the country in scoring offense and defense and led the Great Midwest in total yards per game and yards allowed per game. On Thursday, Findlay would improve in all areas, putting up 578 total yards while holding the Pioneers to just 104 total yards, the least yards allowed by the Oilers in a game this season.

Findlay got the scoring started with six minutes into the game when senior Daouda Sylla rushed three yards, capping an 81-yard drive with a touchdown, his league-leading 15th rushing score of the year. Sylla would leave the game in the second quarter with an injury.

The first half of play was dominated by the Oilers who would lead 28-0 at the break. In the first half, Findlay put up 352 yards of offense and made 16 first downs. The #22 team in the country did not allow the Pioneers to reach the first down marker until 9:30 left in the first half.

Just two minutes into the second half, Findlay again found the end zone when backup quarterback Adam Bertke found junior Jason Moore for his second touchdown catch of the game. With the reception, Moore would move into a tie with Rick Hatfield (1976-79) for the most touchdown receptions in a career at Findlay with 34. The Oberlin, Ohio native also passed Seth White (2011-14) for second place on the all-time receptions list. Moore now has 152 career receptions.

Taking the bulk of the carries after Sylla's exit would be junior Michael Campbell who tallied 136 yards on 20 carries. He rushed for a pair of touchdowns. Campbell's performance marks consecutive games where he has rushed for at least 135 yards and a score.

Freshman Terrence Smith would lead the Oilers in tackles with a career-high eight stops. He had one tackle-for-loss in the game while junior Tyler Long would finish with seven tackles and 1.5 tackles-for-loss. Sophomore Isaac Miles ended the game with five tackles, two tackles-for-loss, one sack, and a fumble recovery while senior Aaron Ivory, last week's Great Midwest Defensive Player of the Week, had two tackles and led the team with two pass-breakups.

The Battlers, led by first year head coach Salvatore Dewalt, were picked fourth in the G-MAC preseason poll. They are currently seventh out of eight in the league with a 1-4 mark in conference play and 2-7 record overall after a 2016 season where the team finished 9-2 and won the Great Midwest Athletic Conference championship. In the four year history of Alderson Broaddus football being an official varsity sport, the Battlers have finished three seasons with a winning record.

AB began the season with a pair of losses before earning their first victory, at home against Lincoln (Pa.). Their only other win of the season came on Oct. 7 against G-MAC foe, Malone. In 2017, the Battlers, who need to win their final two games to avoid have the fewest wins in a season in the programs history, have yet to win a road contest.

The Battlers' offense is led by Jamil Collison-Cofie who has rushed the ball 89 times for 503 yards, sixth in the conference in that category. He has a nose for the endzone and is tied for fourth in the league with seven rushing scores.

Taking the bulk of the snaps for AB is their sophomore quarterback Connor McWilliams. He currently ranks fourth in the league with 103 completions, although his seven interceptions thrown are second-most in the league.

Leading a defense that ranks third in the Great Midwest in tackles for loss is a 225-pound defensive lineman, Quade Raley. Raley is tied with Findlay's Johnny Hopkins for the league lead with 12 tackles-for-loss this season and leads his team with 63 total tackles. He is also one of only five players on the team to record an interception this season.

Philippi, W.Va. - ABU took on Hillsdale at home and, despite jumping out to a 21-7 lead through one quarter, the Battlers fell by a score of 37-31. The Battler offense tallied 521 yards of total offense as true-freshman quarterback Patrick Bentley passed for 344 yards on 17-of-27 passing. He finished with two touchdowns as well with one interception. Out wide, the Battlers were led by Zack Lake who finished with three catches for 122 yards while senior Braxton Johnson caught five passes for 104 yards. Each finished with one TD reception.

Battlers Last Time Out

In the second quarter, the Battler offense drove nine-plays and 31-yards and on fourth down, Bridgett was stopped at the one and fumbled as Merrick Canada picked up the loose ball and took it 97-yards to the house to cut the AB lead to 21-14.

Later in the guarter, the Battlers had another nice drive, this time for 77-yards, but the Charger defense held the Battlers for three as D.J. Opsatnik made a 20-yard field goal to extend the lead to 10 with 3:37 left. Just before the end of the half, Hillsdale cut the halftime deficit to three, 24-21, when Chance Stewart threw a TD pass to Trey Brock.

In the second half of action, Hillsdale took a 27-24 lead on another Brock TD, this time from 46-yards out, and then later in third, Hillsdale extended the lead to 10 when Timmy Mills caught a 50-yard touchdown reception from Stewart.

In the fourth quarter, Hillsdale took a 37-24 lead on a 35-yard field goal from Joe Phillip but the Battlers didn't go away. AB quickly drove down the field on back-to-back passes of 38 and 21 yards to Johnson with the second one finding the end zone to cut the lead to 37-31. On the next drive, the Battler defense forced Hillsdale to punt and AB took over at its own 10 with two minutes to go. After a 25-yard pass to Lake for a first down on the first play, Hillsdale recorded a sack on second down and then Bentley's third and fourth down passes fell incomplete as Hillsdale held on for the 37-31 victory.

Findlay Record Watch

Rhys Gervais: Gervais is rewriting the record books, both season and career. In his time as the Oilers signal-caller, the Puyallup, Wash. native has completed 566-of-883 passes for 7,604 yards and 76 touchdowns, all of which are career records at Findlay.

He owns the top two passing seasons as well with 2,835 yards in 2016 and a record 3,353 passing yards in 2015 making him the first quarterback in Findlay Oilers history to have multple seasons with multiple 2,300+ seasons. The only other QB to come close is Clay Belton who threw for 2,039 yards in 2010 and 2,329 yards in 2011. Gervais is also the only QB to have multple seasons with 20+ touchdowns.

Along with season and career records, Gervais has set multiple single-game records, as well. Since coming to Findlay, Gervais has had three games in which he has thrown five touchdown passes which is tied for the most in a game in Findlay history. The only other player to have five TDs in a game was Bo Hurley who did so against Taylor University in 1997.

Gervais has also attempted and completed more passes in a game than anyone else in Findlay history when he complete 34-of-59 passes last season against Ohio Dominican. His 507 passing yards against Tiffin in 2015 are also a Findlay record.

On Oct. 20 against Kentucky Wesleyan, Gervais passed Bo Hurely as Findlay's all-time total offense leader. Gervais currently is responsible for 7,727 yards.

Jason Moore: In 2016, the Moore had one of the best seasons a wide receiver has had at Findlay. He caught 71 balls (T3 in a season at UF) for a scool record 1,115 yards and 15 touchdowns, also a school record. Because of his incredible succes last season, he is now approaching some career records as well.

In his career, Moore has 149 career receptions, tied for third alltime at Findlay. He needs 8 receptions to catch Dylan Blunk (2013-16) for second and needs 28 to catch Lloyd Henry (2011-14) at 177, the all-time record. The Oberlin, OH native has caught 34 touchdown passes in his career, tied for first all-time at Findlay. With his next touchdown, Moore will become the all-time receiving touchdown leader.

Moore's 12 touchdown catches this season at fourth-most in a season at UF.

Moore is also creeping up on the receiving yards in a career record at Findlay. He currently has 2,386 yards. Moore is now third all-time at Findlay in receiving yards and needs 17 yards to catch Scott McLaughlin (1991-94) for second all-time and 126 to pass Lloyd Henry (2011-14) to become the Oilers' all-time leading receiver.

Findlay Offense: As a team, Findlay has scored 429 points, fifthmost all time at Findlay. The Oilers need 138 points to catch the highest scoring team in history at UF (1997 | 567 points).













Oilers in Week 10: Findlay has a 5-1 record in Week 10 games in the Rob Keys era. In last season's Week 10 game, Findlay hosted Northwood and earned the Senior Day victory 28-13.

National Ranking: In the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) poll that was released on Oct. 30, the Oilers found themselves ranked #22 in the country for the second consecutive week. It's the first time since 2003 that Findlay has been in the poll twice in the same season.

Regional Ranking: In the second week of regional rankings, the Oilers are ranked fourth in Super Region One.

Historic Season: With an 8-1 record this season, the 2017 squad continues its best season in the Rob Keys era. With one more win, it would be the most wins under Rob Keys and the most since a nine-win season in 2002. The Oilers have not started a season 8-1 or 9-0 since 2002 and now have had two such seasons since the year 2000 (2002 / 2017). In the 125 year history of Findlay football, the Oilers have now been at least 8-1 or better through nine weeks in just 12 seasons.

Streaking: The Oilers current seven-game winning streak is the longest in the NCAA Division II era of Findlay football and is the first to happen at Findlay since 1997 when Dick Strahm coached the Oilers to a perfect 14-0 season and captured an NAIA National Championship.

Dominating Opponents: The Oilers have outscored their opponents 374-50 over the course of their seven-game winning streak, winning those games by an average of 46.3 points. The 374 points scored are the most points scored over any seven-game stretch in school history. Findlay has scored more points in the past seven games than all but three teams at UF have scored in an entire season since the year 2000.

Along with the massive offensive numbers, Findlay's defense has held its opposition to just 50 points in seven games, the least amount of points allowed over a seven-game stretch since 1995 (allowed 39 points in a seven-week stretch) and the least amount of points allowed over a seven-game stretch in the NCAA Division II era of Oilers' football.

Against Different Conferences: Findlay is 1-1 against the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC), 1-0 against the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), 1-0 against the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC), and 5-0 against the Great Midwest Athletic Conference (GMAC).

60-point games: Findlay has scored 60+ points in three games this year, the most 60+ point games in a season in school history. With all the high scoring games, Findlay owns four of the top six scoring games in Great Midwest history.

300-yard rushing games: The Oilers have five games this year with 300+ yards rushing, the first time that has happened since 2013.

The Total Package: The Oilers are ranked in the top six in the nation in both scoring offense (47.7 ppg / 3rd in nation, 2nd in region) and scoring defense (12.3 ppg / 6th in nation, 3rd in region). Only two other teams in the country are in the top-10 in both (Minnesota St. & Assumption).

Defensive Dominance: In 2015, the Oilers' defense was giving up 468.3 yards per game, second-to-last in the GLIAC, ahead of only Lake Erie who gave up 533.5. In 2016, Findlay turned up the pressure on defense, limiting opponents to 386.3 yards per game, eighth in the GLIAC. That improvement showed on the scoreboard as their scoring defense improved from 37.2 ppg to 26.0 ppg allowed.

This season, that defense has been taken to a new level. Findlay's defense is allowing just 12.3 points per game and gets off the field in a hurry, allowing opponents to have a time of possession of just over 26 minutes per game, best in the region and sixth in the country. Findlay has been lights out is in the secondary where the self-titled 'Air Marshalls' are helping lead the way for a defense that has intercepted 12 passes, 22nd in the country, and has scored four defensive touchdowns, eighth in the country.











G-MAC Preseason Poll: The Oilers were picked to finish third in the eight-team Great Midwest Athletic Conference this season. Findlay received two first place votes and is selected to finish behind Ohio Dominican and Hillsdale College. Alderson Broaddus, last year's G-MAC champion, received one first place vote.

G-MAC Player of the Week: The Oilers have won two Offensive Player of the Week awards from the conference this season. Daouda Sylla won the award in Week 1 (28 carries | 183 yards | 3 TD) and Jason Moore won in Week 2 (9 catches | 125 yards | 3 TD).

In Week 4, Johnny Hopkins snagged his first Great Midwest Defensive Player of the Week award when he picked up six tackles, three tackles-for-loss, and two sacks. Another Defensive Player of the Week award came in a Week 6 win over Hillsdale as Isaac Miles earned the award highlighted by a fumble recovery that led to the first Oilers touchdown of the day. In Week 8, senior Aaron Ivory earned the award on defense with four tackles and a pick-six, his third of the year.

Lindy's Preseason All-Americans: Junior wide receiver Jason Moore and senior offensive lineman Andrew Alten were named preseason all-Americans by Lindy's Sports in 2017. Alten was listed on first team while Moore earned second team honors. They were the only players on the list that represented the Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

300-Yard Passing Games: Junior quarterback Rhys Gervais holds the University of Findlay record for 300-yard passing games in a career with 11. He had five such games in 2015 and added four more a season ago. The previous record for 300-yard games in a career was six.

His lone 300-yard performance this season came against Hillsdale where, coming off two inactive weeks due to injury, Gervais lit up the Chargers for 332 yards.

Air Raid: Gervais has been one of the best quarterbacks in the region in the last two seasons. In 2015 he finished atop the GLIAC in passing yards per game (304.8), the ninth-best total in the country that year. His passer rating of 163.5 was fourth in the country. In 2016, Gervais was second in the GLIAC in passing yards per game (257.7).

So far, Gervais' accuracy has been the big improvement as he is completing passes at 71.3%, his highest to date. He is also throwing less interceptions, just four this year compared to 11 at this point last season. This season Gervais has a passer rating of 185.8. If that continues, it would be his highest since taking over the quarterbacking duties at Findlay.

Short Outings: Through nine games this season, Rhys Gervais has only played three games in their entirety. Because of the high scores, the Oilers have had three quarterbacks appear in at least five games, the first time that has happened since 2014 (Verlon Reed, Mitchell Faine, Jesse Slone).

A Positive Transition: Daouda Sylla, who spent his first two years at Findlay as a linebacker, has made the transition to running back flawlessly. In 20 games as a tailback, Sylla has rushed for 1,724 yards (86.2 ypg) and 20 touchdowns.

1,000-yard rusher: In the Oct. 20 win over Kentucky Wesleyan, Daouda Sylla eclipsed the 1,000 yard mark for the season becoming the 21st player in Findlay history to have a 1,000 season. Allen Smith had a pair of 1,000 yard seasons (1964, '65) while Nelson Bolden (1978, '79, '80) and Monterae Williams (2009, '10, '11) did so three times.

Experience on Offensive Line: The University of Findlay offensive line has four players that returned from last year's squad. The combination of Andrew Dickinson, Neal Davis, Christian Olmstead, and Lindy's Preseason First Team All-American Andrew Alten have combined for 94 starts in their careers. That experience has been comforting to Findlay's quarterbacks as the offensive line is allowing just 0.33 sacks per game, second in NCAA Division II in that statistic.

The combo of Dickinson, Davis, Olmstead, Alten, and Clay Colvin have started in all nine games this season.

Big Targets: Wide receiver Drew Ogletree stands at 6'5", making him the tallest wide receiver in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. When he and Jason Moore, who measured 6'3", are on the field together, they are the tallest duo of wide receivers in the conference, which has been beneficial to the Oilers as the two have combined for 15 receiving touchdowns this season, the most of any wide receiver combo in the league.

Oilers in the NFL: On October 18, 2017, the New York Jets announced the signing of Harold Jones-Quartey to their practice squad.

Former UF football standout Harold Jones-Quartey spent time in 2015-16 playing for the Chicago Bears. Jones-Quartey played in all 16 games in 2016, starting in 12, and in that season, he was the second-leading tackler on the team with 63 stops. He had one interception and five passes defended.

Jones-Quartey was named second team all-conference as a senior (2014) and was a first team all-league pick during his junior season with the Oilers. He led the Oilers defense with 105 tackles as a senior. His 70 solo stops on the year ranked third in the conference and he also added 3.5 tackles for a loss.

Jones-Quartey was also an honorable mention All-American pick by D2Football.com for his performance during the 2014 campaign.

The Columbus, Ohio native ended his career with 241 tackles. He also picked off four passes and forced three fumbles during his tenure with the Oilers.

Jones-Quartey becomes the first Oilers football player to make a roster since offensive lineman Keith Cupp and running back Dana Wright saw action for the Cincinnati Bengals during the NFL strike season of 1987.

Cupp played in three games during the strike season while Wright appeared in five contests, registering 74 yards rushing and 28 yards receiving.

Both Cupp and Wright were two-time NAIA All-Americans during their careers at Findlay. Wright ranks fourth all-time in rushing yards at UF with 3,335 and his 1,824 yards in the 1985 season is a school record.

Former UF all-conference tight end Mark Inkrott participated in training camps for the NY Giants and Carolina Panthers from 2002-2004 while running back Odell Barry played 26 games for the Denver Broncos from 1964-65. Barry established himself as one of the top kick returners in the NFL, totaling 1,856 career kick return yards and 359 career punt return yards.
