FINDLAY FOOTBALL WEEK 11 GAME NOTES



The Game: The final game of the 2017 regular season has been the most anticipated matchup since the season began. The top two teams in the Great Midwest will square off on Nov. 11 at noon for the right to claim the 2017 G-MAC Championship.

The Matchup

Since the conference schedule was released, the matchup between Findlay and Ohio Dominican in the final week of the season was one that inevitably was going to have major conference implications. Through ten weeks of play, the implications for Findlay could not be any greater.

The winner of this contest will earn their respective school's first Great Midwest Championship in any sport and for football, it will be the first trophy passed out in the newly expanded, eight-team league. Not only is the conference title on the line, but so is a shot at the NCAA Division II Playoffs. With a conference title, a 10-1 record, and a current regional ranking of no. 4, an Oilers win would likely give Findlay the right to host its first-ever playoff game. But the Panthers are not out of the hunt as a win against nationally-ranked Findlay could be enough to vault them into the top-seven in the region.

The two teams enter the contest tied atop the Great Midwest at 6-0 in league play. Both have cruised through their competition and are unquestionably the top two programs in the league this year with Findlay winning its conference games by an average of 44.5 ppg and Ohio Dominican winning their league contests by 32.7 ppg.

This kind of game is not uncharted territory for Findlay. The last time the Oilers were ranked and played for a conference title was 2002 when the #19 Oilers traveled to Allendale to battle #1 Grand Valley St. for a Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletics Conference (GLIAC) title. 6,278 fans watched the Lakers, the eventual National Champion, cruise to a 63-19 victory.

Last Time Out

Findlay, Ohio – Saturday's game, which began with a celebration of the team's ten seniors who played their final regular season home game, saw the two teams combine for 98 points, 35 of which came in the first quarter alone. The scoring started early when junior Michael Campbell capped a five-play, 58-yard drive with a six-yard touchdown scramble to put the Oilers up 7-0.

One minute later, freshman Tyler Lee picked off the Battlers' second pass attempt of the game and ran 47 yards for the score. On the ensuing kickoff, Alderson Broaddus' Maurice Thomas recorded a 100-yard kickoff return to make the score 14-7 just three minutes into the contest.

Campbell would rush for another touchdown and junior Rhys Gervais would throw for three before the half ended, giving the Oilers a 42-7 lead at the midway point of the game.

Coming out of the locker room, junior Adam Bertke found junior Jason Moore on a slant in the middle of the field. Moore broke a pair of tackles and found the end zone for a 56-yard touchdown. It was the 35th touchdown catch of Moore's career making Moore the all-time leader at Findlay in that category.

After a score from Alderson Broaddus to start the fourth quarter, sophomore Nate Slagel produced the longest running play of the season for Findlay, a 75-yard rumble for a touchdown that put Findlay ahead 63-14.

Two more touchdowns from the Battlers would lead to Findlay's final touchdown of the day. After a score by ABU with just 1:44 left on the clock, the Battlers' kicked off in the direction of junior Francis Cutchember who tiptoed the sideline and took off for the end zone, a 95-yard kickoff return for a score.

With all the big plays in this contest, one that will stick in the minds of the players were a pair of plays that won't jump off the stat sheet. Senior tailback Chauncey Bridges, who has produced 2,511 yards and 16 touchdowns in his career and was injured early in the season, took a knee in the victory formation to seal the win.

With the Great Midwest record 70-point performance, the Oilers put the most points on the scoreboard since the scored 70 in a win over St. Xavier in 1997. The 2017 edition of Findlay football has now scored 499 points this season, second-most all-time behind the 567 points scored in 1997.

Findlay put up 581 yards of total offense, 344 passing and 237 rushing, while converting seven-of-nine on third down. The team improved on their +15 turnover margin, intercepting three passes and picking up one fumble recovery.

Ohio Dominican University

ODU has bounced back from an 0-3 start, which came against nationally ranked California (Pa.) and Ashland and FCS opponent Penn, to win its past six games by an average of 32.7 points per game. Last week, ODU outgained Kentucky Wesleyan 638-278 en route to a 63-7 victory in Panther Stadium. The Panthers scored touchdowns on eight of their first 10 possessions and converted 10-of-15 third downs in the 56 point win, tied for the fourth largest margin of victory in school history.

ODU has turned the ball over just six times this season, the fewest in the country, and has just two fumbles against Division II competition. As a team, the Panthers lead the country in completion percentage at 72.6 percent, and senior Grant Russell (Newark, Ohio) leads the nation at 73.2 percent. The Panthers also have the third ranked passing offense at 344.1 yards per game and are seventh in total offense (509.9).

The defense stepped up to limit KWC to just 2.2 yards per carry, the third time this year it has held an opponent to less than 2.5 yards per run. Twenty-five different Panthers had at least 10 tackles in the game, led by a dozen apiece from freshman Dauson Dales (Defiance, Ohio) and junior Tristan Kehres (Shelby, Ohio).

Senior Cameron Kohl (Hilliard, Ohio) continued his climb up ODU's all-time tackles list as he made 10 stops against Kentucky Wesleyan and now has 252 career tackles, which is fifth in Panther history.

Battlers Last Time Out

Columbus, Ohio - Ohio Dominican dominated the Kentucky Wesleyan Panthers, earning a 63-7 victory to win their sixth-straight game, the longest win streak since 2012-13.

ODU threw for 390 yards and ran for 248 more as the Panthers' 63 points are tied for the fourth-most in single-game history, while the 638 yards are the seventh-most. Senior quarterback Grant Russell completed 20-of-26 passes (76.9 percent) for 352 yards and five touchdowns and ran for another score. He moved into second on ODU's all-time passing list as he now has 8,390 yards, moving ahead of Mark Miller (2010-14, 8,261 yards.)

His top target was junior Cory Contini, who tied a school record with four touchdown catches. He caught five passes total for 142 yards and joins Justin Sayre, nearly 10 years to the day (Nov. 3, 2007 against Urbana) as the only Panther wide outs with a quartet of touchdown grabs in a single game. Contini now has 1,006 receiving yards this fall, becoming just the fifth player in school history to surpass 1,000 yards in a single season.

ODU's defense, meanwhile, controlled the action, holding KWC to 87 yards on the ground and 2.2 yards per carry. Junior Tristan Kehres had another superlative week with 12 tackles (2.5 TFL) and a sack and freshman Dauson Dales had a personal-best 12 stops as well. Senior Cameron Kohl (Hilliard, Ohio) finished in double figures in tackles for a third straight week, registering 10 stops.

Findlay Record Watch

Rhys Gervais: Gervais is rewriting the record books, both season and career. In his time as the Oilers signal-caller, the Puyallup, Wash. native has completed 579-of-906 passes for 7,834 yards and 79 touchdowns, all of which are career records at Findlay.

He owns the top two passing seasons as well with 2,835 yards in 2016 and a record 3,353 passing yards in 2015 making him the first quarterback in Findlay Oilers history to have multiple seasons with multiple 2,300+ seasons. The only other QB to come close is Clay Belton who threw for 2,039 yards in 2010 and 2,329 yards in 2011. Gervais is also the only QB to have multiple seasons with 20+ touchdowns.

Along with season and career records, Gervais has set multiple single-game records, as well. Since coming to Findlay, Gervais has had three games in which he has thrown five touchdown passes which is tied for the most in a game in Findlay history. The only other player to have five TDs in a game was Bo Hurley who did so against Taylor University in 1997.

Gervais has also attempted and completed more passes in a game than anyone else in Findlay history when he complete 34-of-59 passes last season against Ohio Dominican. His 507 passing yards against Tiffin in 2015 are also a Findlay record.

On Oct. 20 against Kentucky Wesleyan, Gervais passed Bo Hurley as Findlay's all-time total offense leader. Gervais currently is responsible for 7,839 yards.

Jason Moore: In 2016, the Moore had one of the best seasons a wide receiver has had at Findlay. He caught 71 balls (T3 in a season at UF) for a school record 1,115 yards and 15 touchdowns, also a school record. Because of his incredible success last season, he is now approaching some career records as well.

In his career, Moore has 156 career receptions, third all-time at Findlay. He needs 4 receptions to catch Dylan Blunk (2013-16) for second and needs 23 to catch Lloyd Henry (2011-14) at 177, the all-time record. The Oberlin, OH native has caught 35 touchdown passes in his career, first all-time at Findlay.

Moore's 13 touchdown catches this season are tied for third-most in a season at UF.

Against Alderson Broaddus on Nov. 4, 2017, Moore also became Findlay's all-time leader in receiving yards in a career, passing Lloyd Henry who had 2,410 in his career (2011-14). Moore currently has 2,475 receiving yards.

Findlay Offense: As a team, Findlay has scored 499 points, second-most all time at Findlay. The Oilers need 68 points to catch the highest scoring team in history at UF (1997 | 567 points).

Notes

Oilers in Week 11: Findlay has a 5-1 record in season finales Rob Keys era. In last season's regular season finale, Findlay went north to take on Michigan Tech and came away with a convincing 59-21 victory, their highest scoring game of the season.

National Ranking: In the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) poll that was released on Nov. 6, the Oilers found themselves ranked #21 in the country, up one spot from a week ago. The Oilers also moved up in the D2Football.com rankings and are currently #24 in that poll.

Regional Ranking: In the third week of regional rankings, the Oilers are ranked fourth in Super Region One.

Historic Season: With an 9-1 record this season, the 2017 squad continues its best season in the Rob Keys era. The nine wins are the most since a nine-win season in 2002. The Oilers have not started a season 9-1 or 10-0 since 2002 and now have had two such seasons since the year 2000 (2002 / 2017). In the 125 year history of Findlay football, the Oilers have now been at least 9-1 or better through nine weeks in just nine seasons.

Streaking: The Oilers current eight-game winning streak is the longest in the NCAA Division II era of Findlay football and is the first to happen at Findlay since 1997 when Dick Strahm coached the Oilers to a perfect 14-0 season and captured an NAIA National Championship.

Dominating Opponents: The Oilers have outscored their opponents 444-78 over the course of their eight-game winning streak, winning those games by an average of 45.7 points. The 444 points scored are the most points scored over any eight-game stretch in school history. Findlay has scored more points in the past seven games than all but three teams at UF have scored in an entire season since the year 2000.

Along with the massive offensive numbers, Findlay's defense has held its opposition to just 78 points in eight games, the least amount of points allowed over a eight-game stretch since 1997 (allowed 68 points in an eight-week stretch) and the least amount of points allowed over a eight-game stretch in the NCAA Division II era of Oilers' football.

Against Different Conferences: Findlay is 1-1 against the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC), 1-0 against the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), 1-0 against the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC), and 6-0 against the Great Midwest Athletic Conference (GMAC).

60-point games: Findlay has scored 60+ points in four games this year, the most 60+ point games in a season in school history. With all the high scoring games, Findlay owns the top four scoring games in Great Midwest history.

300-yard rushing games: The Oilers have five games this year with 300+ yards rushing, the first time that has happened since 2013.

The Total Package: The Oilers are ranked in the top ten in the nation in both scoring offense (49.9 ppg / 2nd in nation, 1st in region) and scoring defense (13.9 ppg / 9th in nation, 3rd in region). Only two other teams in the country are in the top-10 in both (Minnesota St. & Assumption).

Defensive Dominance: In 2015, the Oilers' defense was giving up 468.3 yards per game, second-to-last in the GLIAC, ahead of only Lake Erie who gave up 533.5. In 2016, Findlay turned up the pressure on defense, limiting opponents to 386.3 yards per game, eighth in the GLIAC. That improvement showed on the scoreboard as their scoring defense improved from 37.2 ppg to 26.0 ppg allowed.

This season, that defense has been taken to a new level. Findlay's defense is allowing just 13.9 points per game and gets off the field in a hurry, allowing opponents to have a time of possession of just over 27 minutes per game, second in the region and 11th in the country. Findlay has been lights out in the secondary where the self-titled 'Air Marshals' are helping lead the way for a defense that has intercepted 15 passes, 14th in the country, and has scored five defensive touchdowns, fourth in the country.

Findlay's turnover margin of +1.8 per game is the best in the country.

Notes

G-MAC Preseason Poll: The Oilers were picked to finish third in the eight-team Great Midwest Athletic Conference this season. Findlay received two first place votes and is selected to finish behind Ohio Dominican and Hillsdale College. Alderson Broaddus, last year's G-MAC champion, received one first place vote.

G-MAC Current Status: Findlay and ODU are guaranteed to finish in the top two spots with Hillsdale in third. The three teams who made up the entirety of the G-MAC last season are currently tied in the bottom three spots at 1-5 in league play.

G-MAC Player of the Week: The Oilers have won two Offensive Player of the Week awards from the conference this season. Daouda Sylla won the award in Week 1 (28 carries | 183 yards | 3 TD) and Jason Moore won in Week 2 (9 catches | 125 yards | 3 TD).

In Week 4, Johnny Hopkins snagged his first Great Midwest Defensive Player of the Week award when he picked up six tackles, three tackles-for-loss, and two sacks. Another Defensive Player of the Week award came in a Week 6 win over Hillsdale as Isaac Miles earned the award highlighted by a fumble recovery that led to the first Oilers touchdown of the day. In Week 8, senior Aaron Ivory earned the award on defense with four tackles and a pick-six, his third of the year. In Week 10, sophomore Tyler Lee earned the award, intercepting two passes including one for a touchdown.

Lindy's Preseason All-Americans: Junior wide receiver Jason Moore and senior offensive lineman Andrew Alten were named preseason all-Americans by Lindy's Sports in 2017. Alten was listed on first team while Moore earned second team honors. They were the only players on the list that represented the Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

300-Yard Passing Games: Junior quarterback Rhys Gervais holds the University of Findlay record for 300-yard passing games in a career with 11. He had five such games in 2015 and added four more a season ago. The previous record for 300-yard games in a career was six.

His lone 300-yard performance this season came against Hillsdale where, coming off two inactive weeks due to injury, Gervais lit up the Chargers for 332 yards.

Air Raid: Gervais has been one of the best quarterbacks in the region in the last two seasons. In 2015 he finished atop the GLIAC in passing yards per game (304.8), the ninth-best total in the country that year. His passer rating of 163.5 was fourth in the country. In 2016, Gervais was second in the GLIAC in passing yards per game (257.7).

So far, Gervais' accuracy has been the big improvement as he is completing passes at 70.6%, his highest to date. He is also throwing less interceptions, just four this year compared to 12 at this point last season. This season Gervais has a passer rating of 188.9. If that continues, it would be his highest since taking over the quarterbacking duties at Findlay.

A Positive Transition: Daouda Sylla, who spent his first two years at Findlay as a linebacker, has made the transition to running back flawlessly. In 20 games as a tailback, Sylla has rushed for 1,724 yards (86.2 ypg) and 20 touchdowns.

1,000-yard rusher: In the Oct. 20 win over Kentucky Wesleyan, Daouda Sylla eclipsed the 1,000 yard mark for the season becoming the 21st player in Findlay history to have a 1,000 season. Allen Smith had a pair of 1,000 yard seasons (1964, '65) while Nelson Bolden (1978, '79, '80) and Monterae Williams (2009, '10, '11) did so three times.

Experience on Offensive Line: The University of Findlay offensive line has four players that returned from last year's squad. The combination of Andrew Dickinson, Neal Davis, Christian Olmstead, and Lindy's Preseason First Team All-American Andrew Alten have combined for 96 starts in their careers. That experience has been comforting to Findlay's quarterbacks as the offensive line is allowing just 0.50 sacks per game, first in NCAA Division II in that statistic.

Postseason Play: With a win, Findlay all but clinches a bid in the NCAA Division II Playoffs. It would be the first time that the Oilers would qualify for the playoffs in the NCAA era and the first time the Orange and Black would participate in postseason play since the National Championship run in 1997.
