FINDLAY FOOTBALL WEEK 3 GAME NOTES



The Game: The Oilers make the 10 hour trip to Liberty, Missouri to take on the Cardinals of William Jewell out of the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC). The two football programs are meeting for the first time in history.

Both teams enter the contest coming off big losses to two of the nation's top three teams. Findlay dropped their matchup with #2 Ferris St. (48-27) while William Jewell lost their game against #3 Texas A&M Commerce (59-3).

This will be the final non-conference matchup for the Cardinals as next week, they get started with their Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) schedule when they take on McKendree. The Oilers will face Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) member Tuskegee next week before playing their first ever Great Midwest Athletic Conference (GMAC) contest against Walsh on Sep. 30.

Last Time Out



Findlay, OH - The University of Findlay football team suffered their first loss of the season on Saturday, September 9, a 48-27 loss at the hands of the second-ranked team in NCAA Division II, Ferris State. With the loss, the Oilers fall to 1-1 on the year while the Bulldogs begin their season at 1-0.

Ferris State got the scoring started less than a minute into the game when senior standout quarterback Reggie Bell ripped through the defense for an 85-yard touchdown run.

Findlay remained unphased and answered with a touchdown of their own less than five minutes later, a 19-yard score from junior Rhys Gervais to junior Jason Moore, the first of three touchdown receptions by Moore in the game. The extra point was missed which made the score 7-6 with 10:42 to play in the first quarter. The game looked to be a shootout, but 32 accepted penalties would slow the game down with both teams struggling to put together clean drives.

The Bulldogs would extend their lead to 17-6 before Findlay's next score. This score came on a 20-yard touchdown pass from Gervais to sophomore Andrew Ogletree. It was the first touchdown of Ogletree's young career.

21 unanswered points by Ferris State would make the score 38-13 with 9:20 to play in the third quarter. It was too much for the Oilers to overcome as the lead for the Bulldogs would not get inside 21 for the remainder of the game.

The Oilers put up 338 yards of total offense on 234 yards passing and 104 yards on the ground. Led by Bell, the Bulldogs put up 653 yards on the strength of 413 on the ground. Bell ran for 216 yards and scored four touchdowns on 18 carries.

Findlay got a big game from Jason Moore who caught nine balls for 125 yards. He scored three touchdowns. Moore's 125 yards pull him to within just 24 yards of the top five all-time receiving yards at Findlay. He is chasing Mike Chambers (2008-2009) who is currently in fifth all-time with 1,942 yards.

Quarterback Rhys Gervais threw the ball 27 times and completed 18 in the loss. He had 215 yards through the air for three scores. He also had a pair of interceptions in the contest.

Senior Daouda Sylla was the leading rusher for the second time this season. He picked up 80 yards on nine carries.

Junior Justice Jenkins was the leading tackler with 11 stops that included one and a half sacks. Senior Rhonald Houston also had double-digit tackles with ten while junior Francis Cutchember had nine.

William Jewell

The William Jewell Cardinals, who first played NCAA Division II football in the 2012 season, enter the contest with an 0-2 record overall and are currently in eighth place in the GLVC standings. WJC was picked seventh out of eight GLVC teams in the conference's preseason coaches poll. Southwest Baptist was selected as the conference's favorite to win the title.

Last season, William Jewell, which has played football since 1888 and has compiled a record of 577-445-51, finished 1-9 on the year, last place in the GLVC. They began their season with nine straight losses before picking up their lone win in the final week of the season.

Under head coach Shawn Weigel, who is now in his third year, the Cardinals are 5-16. However, the Red and Black have 41 returning letterwinners (21 off | 18 def | 2 st) and 18 starters (8 off | 8 def | 2 st).

Key returners for the Cardinals include senior running back Trejuan Mask who last season was named second team all-GLVC in 2015. That year, he rushed 133 times for 612 yards. He scored seven touchdowns. Despite that success, last season Mask only ran for 157 yards on 39 carries. Wide receiver Bulla Graft is another second team all-GLVC returner. Last year, Graft had 658 receiving yards and scored five touchdowns.

Defensively, senior Isaac Dozier is the team's leading tackler at linebacker. A year ago he earned second team all-GLVC while racking up 82 tackles including 66 solo tackles. Dozier has eight tackles through two games this season.

This Week's Facts

- The Oilers have a record of 3-3 in Week 3 games under head coach Rob Keys.
- Last season's Week 3 matchup sent the Oilers to Ashland to take on the #5 Eagles. Findlay lost that game 35-3.
- This is the first time Findlay has played William Jewell. The Oilers have an all-time record of 75-61-6 in games against first-time opponents.
- The most recent first-time opponent is McKendree, also out of the GLVC. Those teams first met in 2013 with Findlay winning 38-21.
- The largest margin of victory in a first-time meeting for Findlay was a 70-0 win over Northwood in 1962.
- WJC, which went 1-9 last season, last had a winning season in 2013-14 when they finished 5-4. It is their only winning season since joining NCAA Division II in 2012.
- Before joining the ranks of the NCAA, William Jewell College was the first NAIA school to win 500 football games.

Cardinals Last Time Out

On Saturday, Sep. 9, the Cardinals traveled to Commerce, Texas to take on third ranked Texas A&M Commerce. WJC lost in that game by a final of 59-6, their largest margin of defeat since Oct. 19, 2013, a 56-3 loss to UIndy.

Trailing 7-0 early in the first quarter, the Cardinals forced the Lions to punt, but the kick was downed on the WJC 3-yard line. Two plays later, Cardinals' quarterback Brad Strauss threw an interception, giving the Lions the ball on the WJC 13-yard line. Three plays later, the Lions scored to take a 14-0 lead, the start of a 59 point run.

The Cardinals did not score until the horn sounded in the fourth quarter. On the last play of the game, Strauss found Nick Fisher for an 8-yard touchdown to break the shutout.

Findlay Record Watch

Rhys Gervais: Gervais is rewriting the record books, both season and career. In his time as the Oilers signal-caller, the Puyallup, WA native completed 490-of-786 passes for 6,549 yards and 64 touchdowns, all of which are career records at Findlay.

He owns the top two passing seasons as well with 2,835 yards in 2016 and a record 3,353 passing yards in 2015 making him the first quarterback in Findlay Oilers history to have multiple seasons with multiple 2,300+ seasons. The only other QB to come close is Clay Belton who threw for 2,039 yards in 2010 and 2,329 yards in 2011. Gervais is also the only QB to have multiple seasons with 20+ touchdowns.

Along with season and career records, Gervais has set multiple single-game records, as well. Since coming to Findlay, Gervais has had three games in which he has thrown five touchdown passes which is tied for the most in a game in Findlay history. The only other player to have five TDs in a game was Bo Hurley who did so against Taylor University in 1997.

Gervais has also attempted and completed more passes in a game than anyone else in Findlay history when he complete 34-of-59 passes last season against Ohio Dominican. His 507 passing yards against Tiffin in 2015 are also a Findlay record.

Another mark that Gervais is attempting to break is Bo Hurley's individual total offense mark of 7,538 career yards. Gervais currently has 6,662 career yards of total offense, 876 yards shy of Hurley.

Jason Moore: In 2016, the Moore had one of the best seasons a wide receiver has had at Findlay. He caught 71 balls (T3 in a season at UF) for a school record 1,115 yards and 15 touchdowns, also a school record. Because of his incredible success last season, he is now approaching some career records as well.

In his career, Moore has 120 career receptions and needs 18 to join Rick Hatfield (1976-79) and Jeff Rowe (2000-03) in a tie for fourth at 138 receptions. The Oberlin, OH native has caught 25 touchdown passes in his career. Moore needs 7 TDs to catch Schott McLaughlin (1991-94) at 32 for second.

Moore is also creeping up on the receiving yards in a career record at Findlay. He currently has 1,918 yards, 24 yards shy of the 1,942 yards racked up by Mike Chambers (2008-09) who is currently in fifth all-time.

Findlay Notes

G-MAC Preseason Poll: The Oilers were picked to finish third in the eight-team Great Midwest Athletic Conference this season. Findlay received two first place votes and is selected to finish behind Ohio Dominican and Hillsdale College. Alderson Broadbuss, last year's G-MAC champion, received one first place vote.

G-MAC Player of the Week: The Oilers have won each of the first two Offensive Player of the Week awards from the conference. Daouda Sylla won the award in Week 1 (28 carries | 183 yards | 3 TD) and Jason Moore won in Week 2 (9 catches | 125 yards | 3 TD).

Against Top-25 Teams: The Oilers have a 2-10 record against nationally ranked opponents since head coach Rob Keys took over the Oilers football program in 2011. Their two wins came against #22 Wayne State (43-42 OT) in 2011 and against #10 Saginaw Valley State (29-27) in 2012. The Oilers will take on nationally ranked Ferris State University in Week 2 of the 2017 season.

300-Yard Passing Games: Junior quarterback Rhys Gervais holds the University of Findlay record for 300-yard passing games in a career with ten. He had five such games in 2015 and added four more a season ago. The previous record for 300-yard games in a career was six.

Air Raid: Gervais has been one of the best quarterbacks in the region in the last two seasons. In 2015 he finished atop the GLIAC in passing yards per game (304.8), the ninth-best total in the country that year. His passer rating of 163.5 was fourth in the country. In 2016, Gervais was second in the GLIAC in passing yards per game (257.7).

Two-Tailback System: When the 2016 season began, Chauncy Bridges was the clear choice as the team's #1 running back. He proved to be just that with 1,229 yards. Towards the end of the year, Daouda Sylla, a converted linebacker, picked up some steam and finished the year with a solid 592 yards.

In the final game of the year, Bridges ran for 161 yards on 20 carries while Sylla reached 169 yards on 22 carries. He also scored four touchdowns.

They proved this success was not an anomaly as they each eclipsed the 100-yard mark against Tiffin on Aug. 31. So far this season, the duo has combined for 409 yards on 64 carries.

Surprise Sylla: Daouda Sylla has made the transition to running back flawlessly. In 13 games as a tailback, Sylla has rushed for 853 yards and 8 touchdowns.

Findlay Notes

We Want Moore: After a 2015 where he had 69.7 receiving yards per game (11th in GLIAC), Moore vaulted his name to the list of the nation's top receivers in 2016. Last year, Moore averaged 101.4 receiving yards per game (third in GLIAC) and caught 15 touchdown passes (second in GLIAC). Moore's 15 TD catches in 2016 ranked third in the nation among returning wide receivers. Bad-dy Oliver (Colorado Mines) caught 26 TDs while Damon Gibson (MSU-Moorehead) caught 17.

Defensive Improvement: In 2015, the Oilers' defense was giving up 468.3 yards per game, second-to-last in the GLIAC, ahead of only Lake Erie who gave up 533.5. In 2016, Findlay turned up the pressure on defense, limiting opponents to 386.3 yards per game, eighth in the GLIAC. That improvement showed on the scoreboard as their scoring defense improved from 37.2 ppg to 26.0 ppg allowed.

In their Week 1 win over Tiffin, the Oilers surrendered just 13 points which ties the least amount of points allowed in since a 38-0 win against Malone in 2014.
