FINDLAY FOOTBALL WEEK 6 GAME NOTES



The Game: The Oilers return home after beating up the Walsh Cavaliers to earn their first ever Great Midwest victory. Saturday, Oct. 7 will see the Lake Erie Storm invade Donnell Stadium for a GMAC contest slated to begin at 7:00 pm.

Last Time Findlay and Lake Erie Played

Sep. 24, 2016 - The Oilers handled the Storm a season ago when the two squads matched up as Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) opponents for the final time. Findlay posted 27 points in the first period and had a 34-0 lead at the half en route to a 58-13 victory over the then winless Storm. It was, at the time, the most points in a game for Findlay since 2014.

Rhys Gervais would finish the game with 324 passing yards and five touchdown passes, all of which came in the first half of play.

The game against the Storm also marked the emergence of Daouda Sylla as a legitimate threat out of the backfield. For the first time in his career, Sylla eclipsed the 100-yard mark in a game, finishing with 130 yards on the ground. Sylla also scored his first career touchdown in the blowout victory. Chauncey Bridges also rushed for 100+ in that contest as he ran for 103 yards on 13 carries.

Francis Cutchember led the defense with 11 tackles while Justin Ellis had two sacks and Justice Jenkins had a pair of tackles-for-loss.

In the game, Findlay gained 678 yards of offense, the most in a game under head coach Rob Keys.

Last Time Out



Canton, Ohio - The University of Findlay football team wasted no getting their first Great Midwest Athletic Conference (GMAC) win as they traveled to Canton and knocked off Walsh University by a score of 47-3. The win, which came on Saturday, Sep. 30, gives the Oilers a 4-1 record overall with a 1-0 mark in conference play while the Cavaliers fall to 0-5, 0-1 in conference. The Oilers have outscored their opponents in the previous three games by 143 points (163-20) and are averaging 54.3 points per game in that stretch.

The Oilers would score on seven of their ten possessions, not including a 32-yard interception return for a touchdown by senior Aaron Ivory.

Findlay outgained the Cavaliers 548 yards to 183, the second consecutive game that the Orange and Black held their opponent to under 200 yards of total offense. Walsh was only able to manage 55 passing yards in the game, the first time since last year's game against Michigan Tech that an opposing team had less than 100 yards through the air.

On offense, the Oilers had 281 passing yards, 272 of which came from Adam Bertke who was making his first career start in place of the injured Rhys Gervais. Bertke had a solid performance, completing 14-of-26 passes for 272 yards and three scores.

Senior Daouda Sylla reached the century mark for the fourth time this season on the ground, rushing 21 times for 113 yards and one touchdown while sophomore Nate Slagel picked up 11 carries for 90 yards.

Senior Airion Kosak picked up a season-high with 87 yards receiving on three receptions, two of which found the end zone. Junior Jason Moore had five catches for 84 yards while junior Jacob Allton caught four balls for 84 yards.

Aaron Ivory had a game to remember to lead the stout Oilers defense. The Cleveland, Ohio native recorded a team-high seven tackles, had one pass breakup, returned an interception for a touchdown, and in the third quarter, picked up a blocked punt.

Junior Chiebuka Chukwuneke also recorded seven tackles while fellow junior Francis Cutchember recorded six tackles, two for loss, and had a pass breakup.

Lake Erie Storm

The Lake Erie Storm enter the contest with a 1-4 mark overall and a 1-1 record in Great Midwest play. The 0-4 start to begin the year marks the second consecutive year in which the Storm have lost their first four games and is the eighth straight year in which they have lost four of their first five games (started 3-2 in the 2009 season).

After a 27-point loss to begin the year on the road, the Storm returned home in back-to-back weeks and were dealt 51 and 27-point losses by Tiffin and Urbana, respectively. After another 51-points loss, this time to Ohio Dominican, the Storm earned their first victory of the year last week, Sep. 30, when they hosted the defending Great Midwest Champion, Alderson Broaddus.

When Lake Erie has the ball in their possession, they are extremely young as they have no seniors that have gained a yard of offense. That youth has been apparent on the score board with the Green and White putting up just 7.2 points per game, the lowest total in the GMAC and the second-lowest total in the nation (only Lock Haven out of the Pennsylvania State Athletics Conference is scoring less PPG | 6.6).

The defense has not been much better as the Storm are allowing 444.6 yards of offense per game. That is good for fifth in the Great Midwest but ranks 134 in the country.

Head Coach Gerald Hazzard, who took over with four games left in the 2016 season, earned his first win as a head coach with last week's win over Alderson Broaddus. He now has a record of 1-8 to begin his career in Painesville.

This Week's Facts

- The Oilers have a record of 3-3 in Week 6 games under Rob Keys. Last season in the sixth game, Findlay lost to Wayne State 37-21. Findlay's last Week 6 win came in 2014, a 47-7 win against Walsh.
- With a 4-1 start to the season, the 2017 squad is tied for the best start to a season since Rob Keys took over as head coach in 2011 (only other 4-1 start came in 2012).
- The Oilers have not started a season 5-1 since 2009.
- Findlay has won three straight games by 35 or more points, the only time that has happened in the NCAA era of Oilers' football and the first time it has happened since 1997.
- Findlay is ranked in the top-ten in the country in multiple statistics including total offense (7th | 507.4 yd/g), rushing offense (8th | 273.8 yd/g), passing efficiency (4th | 189.23), scoring offense (8th | 43.6 pt/g), 3rd down conversion percentage (6th | 52.5%), net punting (7th | 40.00 yd/punt), time of possession (6th | 34:06), first downs (2nd | 137), and sacks allowed (2nd | .40 sk/g). Each of these is tops in the conference.
- Lake Erie hasn't won back-to-back games since 2014 when they rattled off three wins in a row (Notre Dame, Saginaw Valley St, Malone).

Painesville, Ohio - The Storm trailed the defending conference champion Alderson Broaddus 15-3 entering the fourth quarter, but a pair of late touchdowns would give Lake Erie the 16-15 lead with 5:54 left to play.

The teams traded punts before the Battlers got the ball for the final time with 2:43 remaining. ABU drove 65 yards before facing a 4th and 9 at Lake Erie's 15-yard line. The 32-yard, go ahead field goal was missed wide left, giving the Storm the ball with only 19 seconds left. Quarterback James Moore took a knee to end the contest.

Findlay Record Watch

Rhys Gervais: Gervais is rewriting the record books, both season and career. In his time as the Oilers signal-caller, the Puyallup, Wash. native completed 519-of-819 passes for 7,001 yards and 70 touchdowns, all of which are career records at Findlay.

He owns the top two passing seasons as well with 2,835 yards in 2016 and a record 3,353 passing yards in 2015 making him the first quarterback in Findlay Oilers history to have multiple seasons with multiple 2,300+ seasons. The only other QB to come close is Clay Belton who threw for 2,039 yards in 2010 and 2,329 yards in 2011. Gervais is also the only QB to have multiple seasons with 20+ touchdowns.

Along with season and career records, Gervais has set multiple single-game records, as well. Since coming to Findlay, Gervais has had three games in which he has thrown five touchdown passes which is tied for the most in a game in Findlay history. The only other player to have five TDs in a game was Bo Hurley who did so against Taylor University in 1997.

Gervais has also attempted and completed more passes in a game than anyone else in Findlay history when he complete 34-of-59 passes last season against Ohio Dominican. His 507 passing yards against Tiffin in 2015 are also a Findlay record.

Another mark that Gervais is attempting to break is Bo Hurley's individual total offense mark of 7,538 career yards. Gervais currently has 7,114 career yards of total offense, 424 yards shy of Hurley.

Jason Moore: In 2016, the Moore had one of the best seasons a wide receiver has had at Findlay. He caught 71 balls (T3 in a season at UF) for a school record 1,115 yards and 15 touchdowns, also a school record. Because of his incredible success last season, he is now approaching some career records as well.

In his career, Moore has 132 career receptions and needs 6 to join Rick Hatfield (1976-79) and Jeff Rowe (2000-03) in a tie for fourth at 138 receptions. The Oberlin, OH native has caught 28 touchdown passes in his career. Moore needs 4 TDs to catch Schott McLaughlin (1991-94) at 32 for second.

Moore is also creeping up on the receiving yards in a career record at Findlay. He currently has 2,106 yards. Moore is now third all-time at Findlay in receiving yards and needs 297 yards to catch Scott McLaughlin (1991-94) for second all-time and 305 to pass Lloyd Henry (2011-14) to become the Oilers' all-time leading receiver.

Findlay Notes

G-MAC Preseason Poll: The Oilers were picked to finish third in the eight-team Great Midwest Athletic Conference this season. Findlay received two first place votes and is selected to finish behind Ohio Dominican and Hillsdale College. Alderson Broadus, last year's G-MAC champion, received one first place vote.

G-MAC Player of the Week: The Oilers have won two Offensive Player of the Week awards from the conference this season. Daouda Sylla won the award in Week 1 (28 carries | 183 yards | 3 TD) and Jason Moore won in Week 2 (9 catches | 125 yards | 3 TD).

In Week 4, Johnny Hopkins snagged his first Great Midwest Defensive Player of the Week award when he picked up six tackles, three tackles-for-loss, and two sacks.

300-Yard Passing Games: Junior quarterback Rhys Gervais holds the University of Findlay record for 300-yard passing games in a career with ten. He had five such games in 2015 and added four more a season ago. The previous record for 300-yard games in a career was six.

Air Raid: Gervais has been one of the best quarterbacks in the region in the last two seasons. In 2015 he finished atop the GLIAC in passing yards per game (304.8), the ninth-best total in the country that year. His passer rating of 163.5 was fourth in the country. In 2016, Gervais was second in the GLIAC in passing yards per game (257.7).

This season Gervais has a passer rating of 190.2. If that continues, it would be his highest since taking over the quarterbacking duties at Findlay.

Consistency at QB: Last week, Adam Bertke got the start at quarterback for the Oilers in place of the injured Rhys Gervais. It was the first time since November 11, 2014 against Northern Michigan (Verlon Reed) that someone other than Gervais started under center for the Oilers.

Experience on Offensive Line: The University of Findlay offensive line has four players that returned from last year's squad. The combination of Andrew Dickinson, Neal Davis, Christian Olmstead, and Andrew Alten have combined for 78 starts in their careers. It has led to success for the Findlay offense.

This season, the Oilers are rushing for 273.8 yards per game, ranked first in the Great Midwest and eighth in the nation.

They have also protected the quarterback extremely well, allowing just 0.40 sacks per game. They ranked first in the conference and second in the country in that statistic.

Findlay Notes

Surprise Sylla: Daouda Sylla has made the transition to running back flawlessly. In 16 games as a tailback, Sylla has rushed for 1,250 yards and 12 touchdowns.

We Want Moore: After a 2015 where he had 69.7 receiving yards per game (11th in GLIAC), Moore vaulted his name to the list of the nation's top receivers in 2016. Last year, Moore averaged 101.4 receiving yards per game (third in GLIAC) and caught 15 touchdown passes (second in GLIAC). Moore's 15 TD catches in 2016 ranked third in the nation among returning wide receivers. Bad-dy Oliver (Colorado Mines) caught 26 TDs while Damon Gibson (MSU-Moorehead) caught 17.

Defensive Improvement: In 2015, the Oilers' defense was giving up 468.3 yards per game, second-to-last in the GLIAC, ahead of only Lake Erie who gave up 533.5. In 2016, Findlay turned up the pressure on defense, limiting opponents to 386.3 yards per game, eighth in the GLIAC. That improvement showed on the scoreboard as their scoring defense improved from 37.2 ppg to 26.0 ppg allowed.

In their Week 1 win over Tiffin, the Oilers surrendered just 13 points and then in Week 4, Findlay shutout Tuskegee, their first shutout since beating Malone 38-0 in 2014. Findlay's defense leads the conference in scoring defense as they are allowing just 16.2 points per game, 21st in the country in that stat.

This year, Findlay's defense leads the Great Midwest Athletic Conference in INT (6).
