### FINDLAY FOOTBALL WEEK 7 GAME NOTES



**The Game:** The Oilers head to Hillsdale, Michigan to take on the Chargers of Hillsdale College in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (GMAC) matchup that features two of the conference's top title contenders. The game, which will be streamed on ESPN3 and WatchESPN, will kickoff at 1:00 pm.

#### Last Time Findlay and Hillsdale Played

**Oct. 15, 2016** - The Oilers hosted the Chargers for their Homecoming Game last season and exploded out of the gate, scoring 40 unanswered points, before eventually earning a 46-28 victory.

Findlay held Hillsdale, which came into the game scoring 31.8 points per game, scoreless until the 10:28 mark in the third quarter. The Chargers would outscore the Oilers 24-12 in the second half.

In the contest, Findlay outgained the Chargers 499 yards to 323. Rhys Gervais had a good day through the air as he completed 23-of-34 for 249 yards and three scores, but the day belonged to Chauncey Bridges. The Farmington Hills, Michigan native had 26 carries and ran for what is still his career-high of 193 yards. He also found the endzone three times. For his efforts, Bridges was subsequently named Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Offensive Player of the Week.

Jason Moore was Gervais' favorite target that day as he finished with nine catches for 107 yards and three scores, part of a stretch of seven straight games that Moore would finish with 100+ yards receiving.

## Last Time Out



**Findlay, Ohio** - Findlay cruised out to a 28-3 lead after one quarter of play and took a 41-3 lead into the half. In the second half, the Oilers outscored Lake Erie 22-0 to close out the game with a 60-point victory. The Oilers' 63 points are the most points scored in a game this year.

The Oilers ran for 374 yards, a season-high, on 47 carries. The GMAC's rushing leaders are now averaging 290 rush yards per game.

Getting his second start of the year, junior Adam Bertke complete 10-of-19 passes for 97 yards and one touchdown.

Finishing with one of his most impressive performances of his career was senior running back Daouda Sylla. The Ypsilanti, Michigan native had 18 carries for a career-high 186 yards and three touchdowns, all of which came in the first half. Sophomore Nate Slagel also rushed for a career high with 102 yards on 11 carries. He, as well as junior Michael Campbell, rushed for two touchdowns.

Senior Airion Kosak picked up a touchdown on special teams when, in the second quarter, he chased a muffed punt into the endzone for a score.

Junior Justice Jenkins had a big game on defense as he picked up seven tackles and had two fumble recoveries. Senior Johnny Hopkins picked up five tackles, two of which were for loss. He also forced a fumble and had two quarterback hurries. Junior Chiebuka Chukwuneke and junior Tyler Long each had an interception in the contest.

### Hillsdale Chargers

The Hillsdale Chargers were chosen to finish second in the Great Midwest by the conference's coaches in the preseason poll and enter the game with a 3-3 record and a 1-1 mark in conference games, currently in third in the G-MAC.

The Chargers, also in their first year in the Great Midwest, are one of the best scoring teams in the league as they are currently second in points per game (32.0), third in touchdowns scored (25), and third in yards per game (467.5). Their defense has also been solid as they ranked second in the league in yards allowed per game (359.0) and points per game allowed (24.7).

Powering the offense is 2016 all-American and first team all-GLIAC performer, Trey Brock who currently leads the Great Midwest with 127.8 receiving yards per game, 8.2 receptions per game, and is tied for fifth with four touchdown receptions. Brock's best game this season was in a seven-point loss to then #14 UIndy. Hillsdale's start receiver had 12 receptions for 302 yards, the most receiving yards in a game in both school and league history and the most receiving yards in a game in NCAA Division II this season.

Throwing Brock the ball is junior Chance Stewart, an honorable mention all-GLIAC performer last season. Stewart is currently third in the league in passing efficiency (140.3), second in the league with 1,579 yards passing, third in the league with eight touchdowns, and second in the league with 119 completions. He also had a big game against UIndy when he completed 31-for-44 for 485 yards and two touchdowns. Stewart currently ranks seventh in Hillsdale history with 5,152 passing yards.

### Chargers Last Time Out

**Columbus, Ohio** - Hillsdale traveled to Columbus to take on the preseason favorite to win the Great Midwest, the Ohio Dominican Panthers. The two teams were tied at the half at 13-13 and were again tied at 27-27 in the fourth quarter.

The Panthers then rattled off a pair of unanswered touchdowns to claim the 14-point victory.

Hillsdale's electric wide receiver, Trey Brock, had a big day as he tied a career-high with 13 receptions in the contest for 175 yards. Sophomore teammate David Grahmn, the Chargers' tailback, rushed 20 times for 109 yards and three scores. He also caught three passes out of the backfield for 58 yards, giving him 167 yards of total offense.

**Findlay Record Watch**

**Rhys Gervais:** Gervais is rewriting the record books, both season and career. In his time as the Oilers signal-caller, the Puyallup, Wash. native completed 519-of-819 passes for 7,001 yards and 70 touchdowns, all of which are career records at Findlay.

He owns the top two passing seasons as well with 2,835 yards in 2016 and a record 3,353 passing yards in 2015 making him the first quarterback in Findlay Oilers history to have multiple seasons with multiple 2,300+ seasons. The only other QB to come close is Clay Belton who threw for 2,039 yards in 2010 and 2,329 yards in 2011. Gervais is also the only QB to have multiple seasons with 20+ touchdowns.

Along with season and career records, Gervais has set multiple single-game records, as well. Since coming to Findlay, Gervais has had three games in which he has thrown five touchdown passes which is tied for the most in a game in Findlay history. The only other player to have five TDs in a game was Bo Hurley who did so against Taylor University in 1997.

Gervais has also attempted and completed more passes in a game than anyone else in Findlay history when he complete 34-of-59 passes last season against Ohio Dominican. His 507 passing yards against Tiffin in 2015 are also a Findlay record.

Another mark that Gervais is atmtpting to break is Bo Hurley's individual total offense mark of 7,538 career yards. Gervais currently has 7,114 career yards of total offense, 424 yards shy of Hurley.

**Jason Moore:** In 2016, the Moore had one of the best seasons a wide receiver has had at Findlay. He caught 71 balls (T3 in a season at UF) for a scool record 1,115 yards and 15 touchdowns, also a school record. Because of his incredible succes last season, he is now approaching some career records as well.

In his career, Moore has 135 career receptions and needs 3 to join Rick Hatfield (1976-79) and Jeff Rowe (2000-03) in a tie for fourth at 138 receptions. The Oberlin, OH native has caught 29 touchdown passes in his career. Moore needs 3 TDs to catch Schott McLaughlin (1991-94) at 32 for second.

Moore is also creeping up on the receiving yards in a career record at Findlay. He currently has 2,129 yards. Moore is now third all-time at Findlay in receiving yards and needs 274 yards to catch Scott McLaughlin (1991-94) for second all-time and 382 to pass Lloyd Henry (2011-14) to become the Oilers' all-time leading receiver.

## Notes

**Oilers in Week 7:** Findlay has a 4-2 record in Week 7 games in the Rob Keys era. In last season's Week 7 game, Findlay defeated Hillsdale College 46-28.

**Historic Start:** With a 5-1 start this season, the 2017 squad is off to the best start in the Rob Keys era. The Oilers have not started a season 5-1 or better since 2009 and now have 19 seasons that have started 5-1, 6-0, or 5-0-1. (only the third time since 2000 when Findlay officially joined NCAA Division II).

**Streaking:** The Oilers current four-game winning streak is the first since 2013 when Findlay closed their season with four straight wins (def. Lake Erie, Ashland, Malone, Walsh).

**Dominating Opponents:** The Oilers have outscored their opponents 226-23 over the course of their four-game winning streak, winning those games by an average of 50.1 points. The 226 points scored is the most points scored over any four-game stretch in University of Findlay history and is the first time in school history that the Oilers have won four straight games by at least 35 points.

Along with the massive offensive numbers, Findlay's defense has held its opposition to just 23 points in four games, the least amount of points allowed over a four-game stretch since 1995 and the least amount of points allowed over a four-game stretch in the NCAA Division II era of Oilers' football.

**Against Different Conferences:** Findlay has played opponents representing four different conferences this season. They are 1-1 against the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC), 1-0 against the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), 1-0 against the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC), and 2-0 against the Great Midwest Athletic Conference (GMAC).

**60-point games:** Findlay has scored 60+ points in two games this year, the first time that has happened since 1997.

**300-yard rushing games:** The Oilers have three games this year with 300+ yards rushing, the first time that has happened since 2013 when Findlay had five 300+ yard rushing games.

**Surprise Sylla:** Daouda Sylla, who spent his first two years at Findlay as a linebacker, has made the transition to running back flawlessly. In 17 games as a tailback, Sylla has rushed for 1,436 yards (84.5 ypg) and 15 touchdowns.

This season, Sylla leads the Great Midwest in rushing attempts (115) and rushing yards (844), is tied for first in the league with ten rushing touchdowns, and is the only rusher in the league with 100+ rush yards per game (140.7 ypg).

**1,000-yard rusher:** Daouda Sylla is just 156 yards shy of the 1,000-yard mark for the season. If he reaches 1,000 yards, Sylla will become the 21st back to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. Allen Smith had a pair of 1,000 yard seasons (1964, '65) while Nelson Bolden (1978, '79, '80) and Montrae Williams (2009, '10, '11) did so three times.

**Defensive Improvement:** In 2015, the Oilers' defense was giving up 468.3 yards per game, second-to-last in the GLIAC, ahead of only Lake Erie who gave up 533.5. In 2016, Findlay turned up the pressure on defense, limiting opponents to 386.3 yards per game, eighth in the GLIAC. That improvement showed on the scoreboard as their scoring defense improved from 37.2 ppg to 26.0 ppg allowed.

This season, that defense has been turned up to a new level. In their Week 1 win over Tiffin, the Oilers surrendered just 13 points and then in Week 4, Findlay shutout Tuskegee, their first shutout since beating Malone 38-0 in 2014. Findlay's defense leads the GMAC in yards allowed per game at just 309.7. They have also allowed just 84 points (14.0 ppg), the best in the conference.

This year, Findlay's defense leads the Great Midwest Athletic Conference in INT (8).

**Time of Possession:** Findlay is in first in the GMAC with an average time of possession of 33:08.

### Notes

**G-MAC Preseason Poll:** The Oilers were picked to finish third in the eight-team Great Midwest Athletic Conference this season. Findlay received two first place votes and is selected to finish behind Ohio Dominican and Hillsdale College. Alderson Broaddus, last year's G-MAC champion, received one first place vote.

**G-MAC Player of the Week:** The Oilers have won two Offensive Player of the Week awards from the conference this season. Daouda Sylla won the award in Week 1 (28 carries | 183 yards | 3 TD) and Jason Moore won in Week 2 (9 catches | 125 yards | 3 TD).

In Week 4, Johnny Hopkins snagged his first Great Midwest Defensive Player of the Week award when he picked up six tackles, three tackles-for-loss, and two sacks.

**Lindy's Preseason All-Americans:** Junior wide receiver Jason Moore and senior offensive lineman Andrew Alten were named preseason all-Americans by Lindy's Sports in 2017. Alten was listed on first team while Moore earned second team honors. They were the only players on the list that represented the Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

**300-Yard Passing Games:** Junior quarterback Rhys Gervais holds the University of Findlay record for 300-yard passing games in a career with ten. He had five such games in 2015 and added four more a season ago. The previous record for 300-yard games in a career was six.

**Air Raid:** Gervais has been one of the best quarterbacks in the region in the last two seasons. In 2015 he finished atop the GLIAC in passing yards per game (304.8), the ninth-best total in the country that year. His passer rating of 163.5 was fourth in the country. In 2016, Gervais was second in the GLIAC in passing yards per game (257.7).

This season Gervais has a passer rating of 190.2. If that continues, it would be his highest since taking over the quarterbacking duties at Findlay.

**Consistency at QB:** In Week 5, Adam Bertke got the start at quarterback for the Oilers in place of the injured Rhys Gervais. It was the first time since November 11, 2014 against Northern Michigan (Verlon Reed) that someone other than Gervais started under center for the Oilers.

**Next Man Up:** After playing in just five games last season, junior Adam Bertke has already made five appearances in 2017, including a start in each of the last two weeks while filling in for an injured Rhys Gervais. In those two games, Bertke has completed 24 passes for 369 yards and has thrown four touchdowns, all while leading the Oilers to a pair of blowout victories over conference opponents.

**Experience on Offensive Line:** The University of Findlay offensive line has four players that returned from last year's squad. The combination of Andrew Dickinson, Neal Davis, Christian Olmstead, and Lindy's Preseason First Team All-American Andrew Alten have combined for 82 starts in their careers. That experience has been comforting to Findlay's quarterbacks as the offensive line is allowing just 0.33 sacks per game, tied for second in NCAA Division II in that statistic.

**First Down Oilers:** Through six games this season, the Oilers have gained 165 first downs, second-most in the nation.

**Big Targets:** Wide receiver Drew Ogletree stands at 6'5" without cleats, making him the tallest wide receiver in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. When he and Jason Moore, who measured 6'3", are on the field together, they are the tallest duo of wide receivers in the conference, which has been beneficial to the Oilers as the two have combined for 10 receiving touchdowns this season.
