### INSIDE THE MATCHUP

#### NEW RIVALRY STARTS WITH FIRST-EVER MEETING

The football programs at Hillsdale College and McKendree University have never faced one another. Until Saturday night. The Bearcats travel to Frank "Muddy" Waters Stadium for their first-ever meeting with the Chargers.

#### LAST WEEK

Both teams enter this Week 3 matchup off wins, by very different means. McKendree intercepted three passes and ran for 265 yards as a team in a 50-0 win over Kentucky State. Hillsdale improved to 2-0 on the season with a come-from-behind 31-27 win over Michigan Tech. The Chargers ripped off 21 unanswered points in the 4th quarter to complete the comeback.

#### ANATOMY OF A COMEBACK

How did Hillsdale rally from a 27-10 deficit to top the Huskies last week? Fourth-quarter domination on both sides of the ball. The Chargers had 11 first downs and 168 total yards in the fourth quarter compared to 19 total yards and no first downs for Michigan Tech. Hillsdale also possessed the ball for 11:36 of the fourth quarter, and was 4-for-6 on fourth-down conversions.

#### GOOD STARTS

The Chargers enter this weekend's game 2-0 for the second year in a row. The program hasn't done that in back-to-back years since 1991-92.
