INSIDE THE MATCHUP

G-MAC CONTENDERS SQUARE OFF IN COLUMBUS

Two new football programs to the Great Midwest Athletic Conference collide after wins in their respective conference openers. Hillsdale travels to Columbus, Ohio to take on Ohio Dominican University. These two GLIAC rivals migrated to the G-MAC together, and start writing a new chapter in their rivalry starting at noon Saturday.

LAST WEEK

Hillsdale had a record-breaking performance at its homecoming game, shutting out Kentucky Wesleyan 56-0. In that game, the Chargers set a new school record for total yards in a game with 659 while recording its first home shutout in 8 years. Ohio Dominican won for the second straight week, 20-3, over Walsh. The Panthers have allowed 3 points in their last 8 quarters of play, bouncing back impressively after an 0-3 start.

CLIMBING UP THE CHARTS

After a pair of big games, QB Chance Stewart has moved up to 7th in school history in career passing yards with 5,152. His favorite target, Trey Brock, ranks 3rd in school history with 2,410 receiving yards and his 139 receptions ranks him 7th in school history. Two weeks ago, each player set single-game school and conference records with 485 passing yards (Stewart) and 302 receiving yards (Brock).

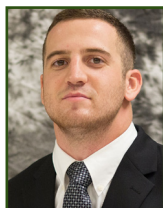

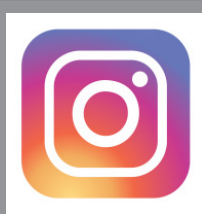
