INSIDE THE MATCHUP

OILERS, CHARGERS RESUME RIVALRY ON ESPN3

Conference championship contenders square off Saturday as the University of Findlay takes on Hillsdale College at Frank "Muddy" Waters Stadium. The game will be broadcast on ESPN3 and on the WatchESPN app.

LAST WEEK

Hillsdale was dealt a 41-27 loss by preseason conference favorite Ohio Dominican in Columbus. The Chargers were 10 points down twice and tied the game three times, but committed two turnovers that led to 14 Panther points. Findlay won its fourth in a row, 63-3 over Lake Erie. The Oilers have outscored their opponents by 204 points during that winning streak, although those four teams have a combined current record of 7-17.

THE SERIES

The Chargers lead the all-time series with Findlay 15-8-1, though the Oilers have dominated recent matchups. Findlay has won three in a row over Hillsdale, averaging 45.7 points per game in those wins. The Chargers' last win in the series came on Nov. 5, 2011.

TREY MAGNIFIQUE

Charger junior WR Trey Brock, an honorable mention All-American in 2016, is having a huge season for Hillsdale. His 767 receiving yards this season are No. 2 in all of NCAA Division II and his 8.2 receptions per game are tied for seventh in the nation. Last week he tied a career-high with 13 catches for 175 yards against Ohio Dominican.


