THE KICKOFF

THIRD STRAIGHT ROAD GAME AWAITS FOOTBALL AS PANTHERS TRAVEL TO FCS PENN

Ohio Dominican's football team returns to the road for its first matchup in program history against an FCS opponent as the Panthers travel to Philadelphia to take on Penn at 1 p.m. Saturday.

This is ODU's third straight road game to start the year, marking just the second time in eight years that the Panthers have played three consecutive regular season contests away from home, and the first time ODU has opened a year with a trio of road games.

A 20-point second quarter by Ashland put ODU in a 27-7 hole last Saturday that the Panthers could not fully rally from. **David Turner's** second touchdown catch of the quarter helped bring the Panthers to within 27-14 at the break, and **Cory Contini** hauled in a 60 yard score to make it a 30-21 game with 8:42 to play in the third.

However, the Panther offense managed just 78 yards on its final three drives, while Ashland scored the final 17 points of the game, to put it away.

Turner and Contini were electric as the duo combined for 320 receiving yards on 15 catches and the three scores. The two had six receptions of 24 yards or longer in the game, and Turner added 167 kickoff return yards to give him 331 all-purpose yards for the contest, a school record.

Grant Russell continued to be sharp behind center as the senior completed 24-of-35 (68.6) percent of his passes for 370 yards and the three scores. He ranks second in the country in passing yards (748), having gone for more than 370 yards in the first two games, and his average of 378.0 yards of total offense is fourth in Division II.

Cameron Kohl set a career high with 2.5 tackles for loss and his 13 tackles were one shy of matching a career-best. **Gus Dimmerling** and **Brian Hunter** each added eight tackles and **Ryan Sayers** had his first collegiate sack to lead the Panther defense.

QUICK HITS

• Since 2006, ODU has an overall record of 86-37 (.694 win percentage.) The Panthers are 40-12 in their last 52 games (.769 win percentage.) ODU has also won 39 of its last 49 regular season games (.796).

• Over the past 52 games, ODU has outscored opponents by 788 points,

an average of 15.2 points per game. The Panthers have scored 30 or more points 34 times in that stretch and held opponents to 14 points or fewer 20 times.

• ODU is 38-8 against opponents from Ohio since 2007 (.826 win percentage.)

• The Panthers are 24-5 in their last 29 regular season road games (.828).

• ODU is 42-2 (.954) in its last 44 games against unranked opponents, dating back to Oct. 15, 2011.

THE COACHES

Kelly Cummings (Eastern Kentucky '93) is in his second season as the head coach at Ohio Dominican, finishing 7-4 in his first year. He joined the program as the defensive coordinator in 2013, helping the Panthers make consecutive postseason trips in 2013 and 2014. Under his tutelage, ODU led the GLIAC in scoring defense in 2013 and led the conference in takeaways in 2014. Cummings helped ODU reach the national quarterfinals in 2014 and ODU was ranked No. 4 in the final polls that season. Prior to arriving at ODU, Cummings spent two years as an assistant coach at Toledo, and he also spent four years at Findlay and five years at Wittenberg coaching on the defensive side of the ball.

Ray Priore (Albany '85) is 14-6 entering his third year at Penn, guiding the Quakers to consecutive Ivy League titles in his first two seasons. Priore has spent virtually his entire coaching career at Penn, starting as an assistant linebacker coach in 1987 and progressing to being the defensive coordinator in 1999 and adding associate head coach to his title in 2006. Penn has captured 12 Ivy League titles during his tenure, and he has coached 25 All-Ivy players in his two years as the head coach.

SCOUTING THE QUAKERS

Penn welcomes back multiple returning starters to its 2017 roster, including running back Tre Solomon (907 yards, 5.2 yards per carry, 9 TDs). While the Quakers will have a new starting quarterback, receivers Justin Watson (89 catches, 1,115 yards, 8 TDs) and Christian Pearson (40 catches, 514 yards, 7 TDs) return, and Solomon caught 33 passes as well last year. Overall, the Penn offense averaged 396.8 yards per game in 2016, with 169.1 on the ground and 227.7 in the air.

The Penn defense was stingy against the run, yielding just 3.7 yards per carry, and the Quakers also picked off 13 passes. Linebacker Colton Moskal returns after leading the defense with 89 tackles, and fellow linebacker Nick Miller was second on the team with 68 stops (6.0 TFL). Defensive end Louis Vecchio led Penn with 5.5 sacks and 10.5 tackles for loss last year.

SHOW ME THE WAY

After missing the last two years due to injury, running back Brandon Schoen, ODU's all-time rushing leader, ranks second among all active Division II backs in career rushing yardage (3,341 yards) and is ninth in rushing touchdowns (31). Schoen needed just 24 career games to break ODU's previous career mark of 2,714 yards, and he has authored 16 career 100-yard rushing games.

In his first collegiate game, Schoen set a school record by running for 298 yards at Grand Valley State in 2012. He ran for 1,007 yards as a freshman, 1,105 yards as a sophomore and 1,134 yards as a junior. He's the only player in school history to have multiple 1,000 yard rushing seasons.

Schoen owns five of the nine longest runs in school history, including a record setting 88 yard touchdown at Grand Valley in 2014, and he holds the school record in career rushing attempts (574) and rushing touchdowns (31).

Schoen was a two-time Second Team All-GLIAC selection and also picked up All-Region honors in 2014.

GRANT IN AID

Senior quarterback Grant Russell had a prolific 2016 season, completing a school-record 69.9 percent (241-of-345) of his passes, ranking second in Division II in completion percentage. An Honorable Mention All-GLIAC pick and a Harlon Hill Trophy Candidate in Super Region Four, Russell threw for 23 touchdowns and ran for 331 yards and three more scores as well.

He earned GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week honors after his performance against Northern Michigan, completing 31-of-35 passes for 384 yards and four touchdowns.

Russell opened 2017 with a 28-of-37 performance at Cal, throwing for 378 yards. He followed that with a 370-yard, 3-TD effort at Ashland. He ranks second in D-II in passing yards (748), fourth in total offense (378.0), eighth in completion percentage (72.2) and ninth in completions per game (26.0).

Over his last nine games, Russell has thrown for 23 TDs against just four picks and completed 74.0 percent (214-of-289) of his passes. In 24 career starts, Russell has completed over 60 percent of his passes 18 times and has 14 multi-TD games.

In 2015, his first year as the starter, Russell had a stretch of 197 consecutive passes without being intercepted that spanned five and a half games. He has thrown just 17 interceptions in 790 career pass attempts, or one every 46.5 attempts.

Russell leads active D-II quarterbacks in career completion percentage (67.3), the fourth-best total among all NCAA levels.

CORY'S CATCHING ON

Junior Cory Contini had a breakout season in 2016, earning Second Team All-GLIAC honors as he ranked fourth in the conference in receptions (69) and yards per game (89.5) while hauling in seven touchdowns. Fifty of his 69 receptions went for first down yardage, and he set career highs in receptions (11) and yards (171) at Northern Michigan.

In five games in October, 2016, Contini averaged 118.6 yards per game. A big play threat, Contini had five grabs of 40 yards or longer last year. Contini's 984 yards were the fifth-most in ODU single-season history and his 69 catches were fifth.

He's been productive to start 2017 as well, ranking 14th in the country in receiving yards (253) and 21st in receptions (7.5 per game). Contini had 97 yards in the opener at Cal and 156 yards at Ashland, averaging 16.9 yards per catch.

ONE KOHL CUSTOMER

Middle linebacker Cameron Kohl emerged as a difference maker late in the 2014 season. He made 35 of his 49 tackles during ODU's three-game postseason run, including 14 tackles, a forced fumble and an interception in the win at Ferris State.

In 2015, he earned Honorable Mention All-GLIAC accolades after totaling 66 tackles (8.5 TFL). In 2016, Kohl registered 56 tackles, including 10 at Ferris State.

Kohl leads ODU with 21 tackles in two games, including 13 stops (2.5 TFL) with a sack at Ashland. He's made 192 tackles in 33 career games played (17.0 TFL) for ODU.

HOLD ME NOW

Redshirt junior Ross Thompson blossomed in his second year as a starter in the linebacking corps, leading the team and ranking 10th in the GLIAC with 94 tackles. That was the seventh-most tackles in ODU single-season history.

Thompson earned his first career GLIAC Player of the Week award after making 17 tackles (4.0 TFL) in the win over Wayne State. Those were the third-most tackles in a game in ODU history.

Thompson ranked 13th in the GLIAC with 10.0 tackles for loss. He made seven or more tackles in eight games, including 13 stops in the opener at Ferris State and 11 more against Northwood. In 23 career games played, he has made 161 tackles (17.0 TFL).

RETURN OF THE MACK

Senior Tre McIntyre stepped into a starting role in 2016 and shined as ODU's "star" linebacker. McIntyre entered 2016 with 25 career tackles in 19 games, and last year ranked fourth on the team in tackles (77) in 11 starts.

McIntyre ranked 17th in the GLIAC in solo tackles (41) and tied for fifth with four interceptions, the most of any linebacker. McIntyre picked off two passes in the fourth quarter at Findlay to help seal ODU's road victory, then clinched the win at SVSU with another fourth quarter pick.

HOP ON THE BUS GUS

Gus Dimmerling spent time at running back and receiver in 2016 spring practices and spent most of fall training camp as a backup quarterback. He switched to the defensive side of the ball before the opener and thrived as one of ODU's starting safeties.

Dimmerling made 11 tackles in each of ODU's first two games against Ferris State and Findlay and also picked off a pass and broke up three others against the Oilers. He ranked 16th in the GLIAC with 80 total tackles and was seventh with eight pass break ups. Dimmerling made at least eight tackles in five games in 2016.

TURNER THE BURNER

David Turner had an impressive debut season in 2016, working his way into the starting lineup at receiver for the final six games. He finished with 32 catches for 359 yards, ranking third on the team in both categories. Turner broke loose against Walsh, hauling in 11 passes for 161 yards and two scores.

Turner was also a threat in the return game. He had a 100 yard kickoff return for a score against Northwood and averaged 25.6 yards per kick return, tops in the GLIAC and 39th nationally. The return for a touchdown was just the fourth in ODU history.

He has continued to excel in 2017, starting the season with 101 yards and a score at Cal and 164 yards and two TDs at Ashland. Turner ranks 12th in the country in receiving yards (265) and is third in all-purpose yards (253.5). He set an ODU record with 331 all-purpose yards at Ashland.
