THE KICKOFF

FOURTH ROAD GAME IN FIVE WEEKS AWAITS FOOTBALL AS PANTHERS TRAVEL TO HALL OF FAME STADIUM

Ohio Dominican's football team bounced back in a big way with a 51-0 win against Lake Erie in week four, and the Panthers will look to keep that momentum rolling as ODU travels to Malone for a 7:30 p.m. kickoff Saturday.

The Panthers are 8-1 all-time against Malone. The eight wins are tied for the most against any opponent in school history, as ODU is also 8-1 all-time against Lake Erie.

After facing a daunting non-conference schedule that featured two of the top-10 teams in the D2Football.com poll and a contest at Penn, ODU racked up 640 yards against Lake Erie, its sixth-highest total in a game in school history, and registered the seventh shutout in program history.

The Panthers scored touchdowns on five consecutive drives in the second and third quarters as the offense continued to roll. ODU had nine plays of 20 or more yards in the game and ripped off 85 plays, one week after being on the field for 86 plays at Penn.

The offense continued to strike quickly, with three scoring drives that lasted less than two minutes. Through four games, the Panthers have nine such scoring drives.

Overall, ODU's offense ranks seventh in the country with 502.5 yards per game, and the Panthers are also 12th in the nation in converting third downs (49.2 percent). The Panthers are also one of 10 teams without an interception thrown.

The wide receiver trio of Cory Contini, David Turner and Cedric Washington continue to excel. The Panthers are the only school in Super Region One (G-MAC, MEC, NE-10 and PSAC) to have three receivers averaging at least 85 yards per game, and one of just two schools (Slippery Rock) to have two receivers (Contini, Turner) averaging better than 100 yards per game.

Meanwhile, the defense authored an impressive performance against the Storm, as 23 different players had at least one tackle in the win. It was the first home shutout since blanking Urbana 56-0 on Nov. 8, 2008. It was the sixth largest margin of victory in school history and tied for the second largest margin in ODU's Division II era, dating back to 2010.

The defense forced Lake Erie into 21 incomplete passes and the Storm threw for just 224 yards on 50 pass attempts, or 4.5 yards per pass. Tre McIntyre made 11 tackles and Shyoun Petteway had nine stops with an interception.

OUICK HITS

- Since 2006, ODU has an overall record of 87-38 (.696 win percentage.) The Panthers are 41-13 in their last 54 games (.759 win percentage.) ODU has also won 39 of its last 51 regular season games (.765).
- Over the past 54 games, ODU has outscored opponents by 821 points,
- average of 15.2 points per game. The Panthers have scored 30 or more points 35 times in that stretch and held opponents to 14 points or fewer 21 times.
- ODU is 39-8 against opponents from Ohio since 2007 (.830 win percentage.)
- The Panthers are 24-6 in their last 30 regular season road games (.800).
- ODU is 43-3 (.935) in its last 46 games against unranked opponents, dating back to Oct. 15, 2011.

THIS WEEK AT ODU

THE COACHES

Kelly Cummings (Eastern Kentucky '93) is in his second season as the head coach at Ohio Dominican, finishing 7-4 in his first year. He joined the program as the defensive coordinator in 2013, helping the Panthers make consecutive postseason trips in 2013 and 2014. Under his tutelage, ODU led the GLIAC in scoring defense in 2013 and led the conference in takeaways in 2014. Cummings helped ODU reach the national quarterfinals in 2014 and ODU was ranked No. 4 in the final polls that season. Prior to arriving at ODU, Cummings spent two years as an assistant coach at Toledo, and he also spent four years at Findlay and five years at Wittenberg coaching on the defensive side of the ball.

Fred Thomas (Youngstown State '79) is in his second season as the head coach at Malone. He previously spent 16 years at Walsh, serving as the defensive coordinator there. He also was the head coach at Girard, Alliance and GlenOak High Schools. He helped guide his alma mater to an NCAA Division II national runner-up finish in 1979. He was the defensive line coach at YSU from 1978-83 and the defensive coordinator from 1984-86.

SCOUTING THE PIONEERS

Malone started the season with a pair of seven point losses, and the Pioneers had a 14-0 lead over Missouri S&T before ultimately falling 48-21 to the Miners. The Pioneers are outscoring foes 28-27 in the first quarter, but have been outscored 42-7 in the second quarter and 31-13 in the third quarter.

John Iacucci is second in the G-MAC with 293.0 passing yards per game and has thrown four TDs. Ashton Dulin had 225 receiving yards against Missouri S&T and has 399 yards total on the season. He also averages 23.2 yards per kick return. Matt Blasiole leads the running backs with 83 yards on the ground.

Ryan Weber has made 52 tackles to lead the defense and has also forced a pair of fumbles, while Josh Correll has made 24 stops.

SHOW ME THE WAY

After missing the last two years due to injury, running back Brandon Schoen, ODU's all-time rushing leader, authored his first 100-yard rushing game since Nov. 22, 2014 as he ran for 126 yards on just 16 carries against Lake Erie in week four. It was his 17th career 100-yard game and he averaged 7.9 yards per carry and scored twice in just over two quarters of work.

Schoen ranks third among all active Division II backs in career rushing yardage (3,498 yards) and is 10th in rushing touchdowns (33). He's also eighth amongst active players in all-purpose yards (4,087). Schoen needed just 24 career games to break ODU's previous career mark of 2,714 yards.

In his first collegiate game, Schoen set a school record by running for 298 yards at Grand Valley State in 2012. He ran for 1,007 yards as a freshman, 1,105 yards as a sophomore and 1,134 yards as a junior. He's the only player in school history to have multiple 1,000 yard rushing seasons.

Schoen owns five of the nine longest runs in school history, including a record setting 88 yard touchdown at Grand Valley in 2014. He was a two-time Second Team All-GLIAC selection and also picked up All-Region honors in 2014.

GRANT IN AID

Senior quarterback Grant Russell has followed up his prolific 2016 season with a hot start to 2017. He has thrown for 1,315 yards (328.8 per game) while completing 73.2 percent of his passes. Russell has 11 touchdown tosses without a pick, and has now thrown 188 straight passes without an interception, a stretch of five and a half games.

Russell was named the G-MAC Offensive Player of the Week after throwing for 273 yards and two scores at Penn. Russell opened 2017 with a 28-of-37 performance at Cal, throwing for 378 yards. He followed that with a 370-yard, 3-TD effort at Ashland.

He ranks sixth in D-II in passing yards per game, third in completion percentage, 11th in completions per game (25.3), 10th in total offense (327.8 per game) and 14th in yards per pass attempt (9.5).

Over his last 11 games, Russell has thrown for 29 TDs against just four picks and completed 74.1 percent (263-of-355) of his passes. In 26 career starts, Russell has completed over 60 percent of his passes 20 times and has 16 multi-TD games.

In 2016, he completed a school-record 69.9 percent (241-of-345) of his passes, ranking second in Division II in completion percentage. An Honorable Mention All-GLIAC pick and a Harlon Hill Trophy Candidate in Super Region Four, Russell threw for 23 touchdowns and ran for 331 yards and three more scores as well.

He has thrown just 17 interceptions in 856 career pass attempts, or one every 50.4 attempts. Russell leads active D-II quarterbacks in career completion percentage (67.9), the fourth-best total among all NCAA levels.

CORY'S CATCHING ON

Junior Cory Contini had a breakout season in 2016 and has continued that into 2017. He ranks fifth in the country in receptions (35) and 14th in receiving yards (469), which is second in the G-MAC. Contini had 97 yards in the opener at Cal, 156 yards at Ashland, and 95 yards at Penn. Against Lake Erie, he made 11 grabs for 121 yards and two scores. Contini now has at least 90 yards in 10 of his 20 career games played and has caught at least five passes in 11 games.

He picked up Second Team All-GLIAC honors in 2016 as he ranked fourth in the conference in receptions (69) and yards per game (89.5) while hauling in seven touchdowns. Fifty of his 69 receptions went for first down yardage, and he set career highs in receptions (11) and yards (171) at Northern Michigan.

In five games in October, 2016, Contini averaged 118.6 yards per game. A big play threat, Contini had five grabs of 40 yards or longer last year. Contini's 984 yards were the fifth-most in ODU single-season history and his 69 catches were fifth.

ONE KOHL CUSTOMER

Middle linebacker Cameron Kohl has been in double figures in tackles in two of the last three games and leads the Panthers with 32 stops on the season, including a team-high 3.5 tackles for loss. He finished with 13 tackles (2.5 TFL) at Ashland and 10 tackles at Penn, and now has 203 career tackles (18.0 TFL) in 34 games. Kohl's 32 tackles rank sixth in the G-MAC, and he's tied for fifth in the G-MAC in tackles for loss.

Kohl emerged as a difference maker late in the 2014 season. He made 35 of his 49 tackles during ODU's three-game postseason run, including 14 tackles, a forced fumble and an interception in the win at Ferris State.

In 2015, he earned Honorable Mention All-GLIAC accolades after totaling 66 tackles (8.5 TFL). In 2016, Kohl registered 56 tackles, including 10 at Ferris State.

HOLD ME NOW

Redshirt junior Ross Thompson blossomed in his second year as a starter in the linebacking corps, leading the team and ranking 10th in the GLIAC with 94 tackles. That was the seventh-most tackles in ODU single-season history.

Thompson earned his first career GLIAC Player of the Week award after making 17 tackles (4.0 TFL) in the win over Wayne State. Those were the third-most tackles in a game in ODU history.

Thompson ranked 13th in the GLIAC with 10.0 tackles for loss. He made seven or more tackles in eight games, including 13 stops in the opener at Ferris State and 11 more against Northwood. In 24 career games played, he has made 164 tackles (17.0 TFL).

RETURN OF THE MACK

Senior Tre McIntyre had his third career game of 10 or more tackles in week four as he registered 11 stops in the shutout win against Lake Erie. He was making his first start at safety after spending the last year and a half primarily as ODU's "star" linebacker. He stepped into a starting role in 2016 and shined. McIntyre entered 2016 with 25 career tackles in 19 games, and last year ranked fourth on the team in tackles (77) in 11 starts.

McIntyre ranked 17th in the GLIAC in solo tackles (41) and tied for fifth with four interceptions, the most of any linebacker. McIntyre picked off two passes in the fourth quarter at Findlay to help seal ODU's road victory, then clinched the win at SVSU with another fourth quarter pick.

HOP ON THE BUS GUS

Gus Dimmerling intercepted a pass at Penn, the second of his career, and also had one breakup. He had eight tackles in the game against Ashland and has 21 total stops on the season, fourth-most on the team. He now has eight or more tackles in six career games.

He spent time at running back and receiver in 2016 spring practices and spent most of fall training camp as a backup quarterback. He switched to the defensive side of the ball before the 2016 opener and thrived as one of ODU's starting safeties.

In 2016, Dimmerling made 11 tackles in each of ODU's first two games against Ferris State and Findlay and also picked off a pass and broke up three others against the Oilers. He ranked 16th in the GLIAC with 80 total tackles and was seventh with eight pass break ups.

TURNER THE BURNER

David Turner had an impressive debut season in 2016 and has continued to excel in 2017. He ranks second in the G-MAC and seventh in the country with 33 catches, and his 405 yards are 26th in the nation and third in the conference behind Contini. He also ranks 24th in the country with four TDs.

Turner started the season with 101 yards and a score at Cal and 164 yards and two TDs at Ashland. He set an ODU record with 331 all-purpose yards at Ashland. Turner then finished with 79 yards and a score at Penn. His 174.5 all-purpose yards per game rank 16th in the country and second in the G-MAC.

Turner worked his way into the starting lineup at receiver for the final six games in 2016. He finished with 32 catches for 359 yards, ranking third on the team in both categories. Turner broke loose against Walsh, hauling in 11 passes for 161 yards and two scores.

Turner was also a threat in the return game. He had a 100 yard kickoff return for a score against Northwood and averaged 25.6 yards per kick return, tops in the GLIAC and 39th nationally. The return for a touchdown was just the fourth in ODU history.

BRIAN'S SONG

Brian Hunter has steadily improved during his three seasons at ODU. The junior defensive end ranks third on the team this fall with 22 tackles and is tied for the team lead with 3.5 tackles for loss. He had a huge game at Penn, making seven tackles (2.0 TFL) while forcing and recovering a fumble and also picking up a sack. He's made at least five tackles in each of the last three games and blocked a field goal against Lake Erie. Hunter is tied for fifth in the G-MAC in tackles for loss.

Hunter has now made 94 tackles (5.5 sacks) and 16.5 tackles for loss in his career. Last season, he finished with four sacks and 8.5 tackles for loss.

CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER

In his first season with the Panther program, sophomore Cedric Washington has proven to be a big play threat as he already has a pair of 100-yard receiving games. Washington racked up 137 yards and two touchdowns at Cal in the opener, with each covering 52 yards, and he tallied 107 yards at Penn as well.

Washington has six receptions of 20 yards or longer, including a 39 yard grab against Lake Erie, and is averaging a team-best 19.1 yards per reception. His 343 yards rank fifth in the G-MAC and 48th in the country.

As a freshman at Lindsey Wilson last year, Washington was named the Mid-South Conference Offensive Freshman of the Year after he tallied 772 yards on 35 catches, averaging 22.1 yards per catch with seven TDs. He had a trio of 100 yard games.

TOTAL ECLIPSE OF THE HARDT

Freshman Logen Neidhardt won the punting job in fall camp and has excelled, earning G-MAC Special Teams Player of the Week for his efforts against Lake Erie. Not only did he average 41.7 yards per punt, his first one carried 45 yards and was downed at the one, leading to a safety. Two of his three punts were placed inside the 20. He was the first true punter in ODU's Division II era to earn a conference player of the week award.

Neidhardt was even better against Penn in week three, averaging 46.0 yards per punt on seven boots, with six of them carrying at least 40 yards and a long of 54 yards.

Eight of his last 10 punts have gone for over 40 yards and he ranks 20th in the country in punting average.
