THE KICKOFF

FOOTBALL RETURNS HOME AS PANTHERS HOST HILLSDALE IN G-MAC CLASH

Ohio Dominican and Hillsdale renew their rivalry on the gridiron as the Panthers welcome the Chargers to Columbus for a Homecoming showdown between the teams projected to finish atop the G-MAC standings.

The Panthers have won three straight in the series, but the last two meetings in 2014 and 2015 have come by six (9-3) and five (34-29) points, respectively. Projected to win the G-MAC in the preseason poll, ODU has won its first two conference games by a combined margin of 71-3. Hillsdale, projected to finish second, won its G-MAC opener 56-0 last Saturday against Kentucky Wesleyan.

ODU's defense has been opportunistic the past two weeks, coming up with three interceptions at Malone last Saturday after picking off a pass and recording a safety the week prior against Lake Erie. Freshman corner **Shyoun Petteway** has started each of the past two games and made 19 tackles with two interceptions and three pass break ups. On 101 pass attempts the past two games, ODU has allowed just 512 passing yards, with just six pass completions of longer than 20 yards.

The run defense has also been stout, allowing 101.5 yards per game over the last two contests and just 3.5 yards per carry. There have been just eight carries of 10 yards or longer on 58 rushing attempts.

Meanwhile, ODU's rushing offense continued to click as the Panthers ran for 240 yards and averaged a season-high 6.3 yards per carry. Starting in place of the injured **Brandon Schoen**, **EJ Colson** ran for 150 yards, including an 85 yard jaunt, on just 12 carries, and **Fred Pitts** tallied 53 yards as well. The Panthers have rushed for 506 yards over the past two games, averaging 6.0 yards per carry.

The Panthers have also continued to excel on special teams. **Logen Neidhardt** picked up his second straight G-MAC Special Teams Player of the Week honor. ODU's coverage team has shined as well, allowing minus-one punt return yards the past two games while downing two punts inside the five.

QUICK HITS

• Since 2006, ODU has an overall record of 88-38 (.698 win percentage.) The Panthers are 42-13 in their last 55 games (.764 win percentage.) ODU has also won 40 of its last 52 regular season games (.769).

• Over the past 55 games, ODU has outscored opponents by 838 points,

an average of 15.2 points per game. The Panthers have scored 30 or more points 35 times in that stretch and held opponents to 14 points or fewer 22 times.

• ODU is 40-8 against opponents from Ohio since 2007 (.833 win percentage.)

• The Panthers are 25-6 in their last 31 regular season road games (.806).

• ODU is 44-3 (.936) in its last 47 games against unranked opponents, dating back to Oct. 15, 2011.

THE COACHES

Kelly Cummings (Eastern Kentucky '93) is in his second season as the head coach at Ohio Dominican, finishing 7-4 in his first year. He joined the program as the defensive coordinator in 2013, helping the Panthers make consecutive postseason trips in 2013 and 2014. Under his tutelage, ODU led the GLIAC in scoring defense in 2013 and led the conference in takeaways in 2014. Cummings helped ODU reach the national quarterfinals in 2014 and ODU was ranked No. 4 in the final polls that season. Prior to arriving at ODU, Cummings spent two years as an assistant coach at Toledo, and he also spent four years at Findlay and five years at Wittenberg coaching on the defensive side of the ball.

Keith Otterbein (Hillsdale '79) is in his 16th season leading the Chargers. Entering the 2017 season, Otterbein's 91 victories with Hillsdale rank him third on the school's all-time coaching wins list. His 151 overall coaching wins rank him number one among all G-MAC coaches. In both 2009 and 2011, Otterbein earned GLIAC and Regional Coach of the Year honors. He was also recognized with those awards in 1992 and 1994 at Ferris State. Otterbein made his mark by becoming the youngest head college football coach in the nation when he was hired by Ferris State before the 1986 season, guiding the team to three playoff appearances.

SCOUTING THE CHARGERS

Hillsdale's offense has come to life the past two games. After averaging 335.0 yards per contest the first three weeks, the Chargers racked up 650 yards at Indianapolis and 659 against Kentucky Wesleyan. Quarterback Chance Stewart has thrown for 766 yards in the two games with six touchdowns and three picks. Trey Brock has hauled in 36 passes for 592 yards and four scores on the year, including a 302 yard, 2 TD effort at Indy. David Graham has led the running game as he has 422 yards and seven touchdowns on the season, averaging 5.8 yards per carry.

Wyatt Batdorf leads the defense with 40 tackles and Spencer Nehls has made 29 stops. Merrick Canada has picked off two passes. Opponents are completing just 54.0 percent of their passes against Hillsdale and averaging 3.6 yards per carry.

SHOW ME THE WAY

After missing the last two years due to injury, running back Brandon Schoen, ODU's all-time rushing leader, authored his first 100-yard rushing game since Nov. 22, 2014 as he ran for 126 yards on just 16 carries against Lake Erie in week four. It was his 17th career 100-yard game and he averaged 7.9 yards per carry and scored twice in just over two quarters of work.

Schoen ranks fifth among all active Division II backs in career rushing yardage (3,498 yards) and is 10th in rushing touchdowns (33). He's also eighth amongst active players in all-purpose yards (4,087). Schoen needed just 24 career games to break ODU's previous career mark of 2,714 yards.

In his first collegiate game, Schoen set a school record by running for 298 yards at Grand Valley State in 2012. He ran for 1,007 yards as a freshman, 1,105 yards as a sophomore and 1,134 yards as a junior. He's the only player in school history to have multiple 1,000 yard rushing seasons.

Schoen owns five of the nine longest runs in school history, including a record setting 88 yard touchdown at Grand Valley in 2014. He was a two-time Second Team All-GLIAC selection and also picked up All-Region honors in 2014.

GRANT IN AID

Senior quarterback Grant Russell has followed up his prolific 2016 season with a hot start to 2017. He has thrown for 1,502 yards (300.4 per game) while completing 72.7 percent of his passes. Russell has 13 touchdown tosses and just one interception, and had a stretch of 208 consecutive passes without throwing a pick snapped at Malone.

Russell was named the G-MAC Offensive Player of the Week after throwing for 273 yards and two scores at Penn. Russell opened 2017 with a 28-of-37 performance at Cal, throwing for 378 yards. He followed that with a 370-yard, 3-TD effort at Ashland.

He ranks second in D-II in completion percentage, ninth in in passing yards, 10th in touchdowns, 13th in yards per pass attempt (9.3), 14th in completions per game (23.4) and 15th in total offense (305.0 per game).

Over his last 12 games, Russell has thrown for 31 TDs against just five picks and completed 73.8 percent (279-of-378) of his passes. In 27 career starts, Russell has completed over 60 percent of his passes 21 times and has 17 multi-TD games.

In 2016, he completed a school-record 69.9 percent (241-of-345) of his passes, ranking second in Division II in completion percentage. An Honorable Mention All-GLIAC pick and a Harlon Hill Trophy Candidate in Super Region Four, Russell threw for 23 touchdowns and ran for 331 yards and three more scores as well.

He has thrown just 18 interceptions in 856 career pass attempts, or one every 48.8 attempts. Russell leads active D-II quarterbacks in career completion percentage (67.9), the fourth-best total among all NCAA levels.

CORY'S CATCHING ON

Junior Cory Contini had a breakout season in 2016 and has continued that into 2017. He ranks eighth in the country in receptions (40) and 24th in receiving yards (504), which is fourth in the G-MAC. Contini had 97 yards in the opener at Cal, 156 yards at Ashland, and 95 yards at Penn. Against Lake Erie, he made 11 grabs for 121 yards and two scores. One of those receptions was featured on ESPN's Sunday NFL Countdown by Randy Moss.

Contini now has at least 90 yards in 10 of his 21 career games played and has caught at least five passes in 12 games.

He picked up Second Team All-GLIAC honors in 2016 as he ranked fourth in the conference in receptions (69) and yards per game (89.5) while hauling in seven touchdowns. Fifty of his 69 receptions went for first down yardage, and he set career highs in receptions (11) and yards (171) at Northern Michigan.

In five games in October, 2016, Contini averaged 118.6 yards per game. A big play threat, Contini had five grabs of 40 yards or longer last year. Contini's 984 yards were the fifth-most in ODU single-season history and his 69 catches were fifth.

ONE KOHL CUSTOMER

Middle linebacker Cameron Kohl has been in double figures in tackles in two of the last four games and ranks second on the Panthers with 34 stops on the season (3.5 tackles for loss). He finished with 13 tackles (2.5 TFL) at Ashland and 10 tackles at Penn. He ranks ninth in the G-MAC in tackles per game and 13th in tackles for loss.

Kohl emerged as a difference maker late in the 2014 season. He made 35 of his 49 tackles during ODU's three-game postseason run, including 14 tackles, a forced fumble and an interception in the win at Ferris State.

In 2015, he earned Honorable Mention All-GLIAC accolades after totaling 66 tackles (8.5 TFL). In 2016, Kohl registered 56 tackles, including 10 at Ferris State.

He now has 205 career tackles (18.0 TFL) in 35 games played, sitting just outside ODU's top 10 list in career tackles.

HOLD ME NOW

Redshirt junior Ross Thompson made 11 tackles (1.5 TFL) in the season-opener at Cal. He has been limited by injury over the last three games, but still has 21 tackles on the season.

In 2016, Thompson blossomed as a second-year starter, leading the team and ranking 10th in the GLIAC with 94 tackles. That was the seventh-most tackles in ODU single-season history.

Thompson earned his first career GLIAC Player of the Week award after making 17 tackles (4.0 TFL) in the win over Wayne State. Those were the third-most tackles in a game in ODU history.

Thompson ranked 13th in the GLIAC with 10.0 tackles for loss. He made seven or more tackles in eight games, including 13 stops in the opener at Ferris State and 11 more against Northwood. In 26 career games played, he has made 171 tackles (17.5 TFL).

RETURN OF THE MACK

Senior Tre McIntyre had his third career game of 10 or more tackles in week four as he registered 11 stops in the shutout win against Lake Erie. He was making his first start at safety after spending the last year and a half primarily as ODU's "star" linebacker.

McIntyre followed that by making eight tackles (1.5 TFL) at Malone and now has a team-high 36 stops. He ranks eighth in the G-MAC with 7.2 tackles per game.

He stepped into a starting role in 2016 and shined. McIntyre entered 2016 with 25 career tackles in 19 games, and last year ranked fourth on the team in tackles (77) in 11 starts.

McIntyre ranked 17th in the GLIAC in solo tackles (41) and tied for fifth with four interceptions, the most of any linebacker. McIntyre picked off two passes in the fourth quarter at Findlay to help seal ODU's road victory, then clinched the win at SVSU with another fourth quarter pick.

HOP ON THE BUS GUS

Gus Dimmerling intercepted a pass at Penn, the second of his career, and also had one breakup. He had eight tackles in the game against Ashland and eight more with a pick at Malone. His 29 total stops are third-most on the team and he's tied for the G-MAC lead with two picks. He now has eight or more tackles in seven career games.

He spent time at running back and receiver in 2016 spring practices and spent most of fall training camp as a backup quarterback. He switched to the defensive side of the ball before the 2016 opener and thrived as one of ODU's starting safeties.

In 2016, Dimmerling made 11 tackles in each of ODU's first two games against Ferris State and Findlay and also picked off a pass and broke up three others against the Oilers. He ranked 16th in the GLIAC with 80 total tackles and was seventh with eight pass break ups.

TURNER THE BURNER

David Turner had an impressive debut season in 2016 and has continued to excel in 2017. He ranks second in the G-MAC and 11th in the country with 38 catches, and his 515 yards are 20th in the nation and second in the conference behind Contini. He also ranks 24th in the country with five TDs. His 166.4 all-purpose yards per game rank 18th in the country and second in the G-MAC.

Turner started the season with 101 yards and a score at Cal and 164 yards and two TDs at Ashland. He set an ODU record with 331 all-purpose yards at Ashland. Turner had another 100 yard performance at Malone with a career long 73 yard touchdown reception.

Turner worked his way into the starting lineup at receiver for the final six games in 2016. He finished with 32 catches for 359 yards, ranking third on the team in both categories. Turner broke loose against Walsh, hauling in 11 passes for 161 yards and two scores.

Turner was also a threat in the return game. He had a 100 yard kickoff return for a score against Northwood and averaged 25.6 yards per kick return, tops in the GLIAC and 39th nationally. The return for a touchdown was just the fourth in ODU history.

BRIAN'S SONG

Brian Hunter has steadily improved during his three seasons at ODU. The junior defensive end ranks fourth on the team this fall with 27 tackles and leads the team with 5.0 tackles for loss, which is fourth in the G-MAC. His 3.0 sacks are third in the conference as well.

He had a huge game at Penn, making seven tackles (2.0 TFL) while forcing and recovering a fumble and also picking up a sack. He's made at least five tackles in each of the last four games and blocked a field goal against Lake Erie. Hunter is tied for fifth in the G-MAC in tackles for loss.

Hunter has now made 99 tackles (7.0 sacks) and 18.0 tackles for loss in his career. Last season, he finished with four sacks and 8.5 tackles for loss.

CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER

In his first season with the Panther program, sophomore Cedric Washington has proven to be a big play threat as he already has a pair of 100-yard receiving games. Washington racked up 137 yards and two touchdowns at Cal in the opener, with each covering 52 yards, and he tallied 107 yards at Penn.

Washington has six receptions of 20 yards or longer, including a 39 yard grab against Lake Erie, and is averaging a team-best 17.7 yards per reception. His 371 yards rank fifth in the G-MAC and 66th in the country.

As a freshman at Lindsey Wilson last year, Washington was named the Mid-South Conference Offensive Freshman of the Year after he tallied 772 yards on 35 catches, averaging 22.1 yards per catch with seven TDs. He had a trio of 100 yard games.

TOTAL ECLIPSE OF THE HARDT

Freshman Logen Neidhardt won the punting job in fall camp and has excelled, earning G-MAC Special Teams Player of the Week in consecutive weeks. Against Lake Erie, he averaged 41.7 yards per punt, his first one carried 45 yards and was downed at the one, leading to a safety. Two of his three punts were placed inside the 20. He was the first true punter in ODU's Division II era to earn a conference player of the week award.

Last week, Neidhardt placed three of his six punts inside the 20 at Malone and averaged 39.5 yards per punt.

Neidhardt was even better against Penn in week three, averaging 46.0 yards per punt on seven boots, with six of them carrying at least 40 yards and a long of 54 yards.

Eleven of his last 16 punts have gone for over 40 yards and he ranks 25th in the country in punting average (41.1). He has placed nine of his 24 punts inside the 20.
