THE KICKOFF

FOOTBALL RETURNS TO HALL OF FAME STADIUM FOR PRIMETIME CLASH WITH WALSH

Winners of four straight, Ohio Dominican's football team heads back to Canton for the second time in a month as the Panthers take on Walsh at the newly renovated Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium for an 8 p.m. kickoff Saturday.

The Panthers have won all five meeting between the two teams as members of NCAA Division II, and have won seven out of eight overall in a series with Walsh that dates back to the NAIA days of both programs.

This is the sixth straight season that ODU has won at least four consecutive games, and with a win Saturday, ODU will also have win streaks of at least five games in four of the past five years.

Last week, the Panthers scored 35 second quarter points to pull away from Alderson Broaddus with a 53-13 win. That was the highest scoring quarter in school history, and ODU's 43 first half points were the most since ODU had 49 in the first half against Marian on Aug. 30, 2008.

ODU rolled up 444 yards of offense in the first half, including 341 in the second quarter alone, as the Panthers outgained AB 570-259. The Panthers have now tallied 500 or more yards in four of seven games this year while throwing for at least 340 yards in six of seven contests. ODU ranks fourth in the country in passing offense at 347.9 yards per game and are ninth in total offense at 503.9 yards per contest.

The Panthers have also protected the ball, turning it over just five times in seven games, which is the fourth-fewest in the country. ODU's rushing attack has also come to life the last four weeks, averaging 218.8 yards per game with 12 touchdowns.

ODU's defense has also stepped up in the four game winning streak. The Panthers have allowed just 10.8 points per game and 366.3 yards per game in the last month, limiting opponents to just 117.0 yards rushing per contest. ODU also has nine takeaways (eight interceptions, one fumble recovery) in the past four games. The Panthers also have 11 sacks in the last four games.

QUICK HITS

• Since 2006, ODU has an overall record of 90-38 (.703 win percentage.) The Panthers are 44-13 in their last 57 games (.772 win percentage.) ODU has also won 42 of its last 54 regular season games (.778).

• Over the past 57 games, ODU has outscored opponents by 892 points,

an average of 15.6 points per game. The Panthers have scored 30 or more points 37 times in that stretch and held opponents to 14 points or fewer 23 times.

• ODU is 40-8 against opponents from Ohio since 2007 (.833 win percentage.)

• The Panthers are 26-6 in their last 32 regular season road games (.813).

• ODU is 46-3 (.939) in its last 49 games against unranked opponents, dating back to Oct. 15, 2011.

THIS WEEK AT ODU

THE COACHES

Kelly Cummings (Eastern Kentucky '93) is in his second season as the head coach at Ohio Dominican, finishing 7-4 in his first year. He joined the program as the defensive coordinator in 2013, helping the Panthers make consecutive postseason trips in 2013 and 2014. Under his tutelage, ODU led the GLIAC in scoring defense in 2013 and led the conference in takeaways in 2014. Cummings helped ODU reach the national quarterfinals in 2014 and ODU was ranked No. 4 in the final polls that season. Prior to arriving at ODU, Cummings spent two years as an assistant coach at Toledo, and he also spent four years at Findlay and five years at Wittenberg coaching on the defensive side of the ball.

Dan Pifer (California (Pa.) '95) is in his first season leading the Walsh football program. In 2016, he guided Olivet to a 9-2 record and an appearance in the NCAA Division III playoffs. After going 0-10 in his first season, he led Olivet to a 6-4 season the next two years. In 2015, Pifer led his team to a 9-1 record. Prior to joining Olivet, Pifer was the offensive coordinator, recruiting coordinator, and special teams coordinator at Trine (Ind.) University for six seasons. He also coached at Hillsdale, St. Francis (Ind.) and Saint Joseph's.

SCOUTING THE CAVALIERS

Walsh is coming off of a 38-0 setback against Hillsdale in which the Cavaliers were outgained 397-187. It was the fifth time in eight games Walsh was held to nine points or fewer.

The Cavaliers attempt just 16.8 passes per game while averaging 41.6 runs per contest. Calvin Gordon leads the ground game with 499 yards and averages 6.3 yards per carry with a long run of 65 yards. Koby Adu-Poku has 231 rushing yards and three TDs while Antwand Wilson leads the team with four touchdowns. Walsh quarterbacks have combined to complete 56.0 percent of their passes for 111.5 yards per game with three TDs and 12 interceptions.

Dylan Garver leads the defense with 63 tackles while Nick Sturgill has made 53 stops. Leondre Crosby is tops on the team with 4.0 tackles for loss. The Cavaliers have allowed 21 passing touchdowns while recording one interception this season.

GRANT IN AID

Senior quarterback Grant Russell has followed up his prolific 2016 season with a hot start to 2017. He has thrown for 2,219 yards (317.0 per game) while completing 72.4 percent of his passes. Russell has 17 touchdown tosses and just two interceptions, and had a stretch of 208 consecutive passes without throwing a pick snapped at Malone.

Russell was named the G-MAC Offensive Player of the Week after throwing for 273 yards and two scores at Penn. Russell opened 2017 with a 28-of-37 performance at Cal, throwing for 378 yards. He followed that with a 370-yard, 3-TD effort at Ashland and also tossed for 381 yards against Hillsdale.

He ranks third in D-II in completion percentage, fifth in yards per pass attempt (9.9), sixth in yards per game, ninth in total offense (325.7 per game), 12th in completions per game (23.3) and 20th in touchdowns.

Over his last 14 games, Russell has thrown for 35 TDs against just six picks and completed 73.5 percent (325-of-442) of his passes. In 29 career starts, Russell has completed over 60 percent of his passes 23 times and has 19 multi-TD games.

In 2016, he completed a school-record 69.9 percent (241-of-345) of his passes, ranking second in Division II in completion percentage. An Honorable Mention All-GLIAC pick and a Harlon Hill Trophy Candidate in Super Region Four, Russell threw for 23 touchdowns and ran for 331 yards and three TDs.

He has thrown just 19 interceptions in 942 career pass attempts, or one every 49.6 attempts. Russell leads active D-II quarterbacks in career completion percentage (68.2), the fourth-best total among all NCAA levels.

CORY'S CATCHING ON

Junior Cory Contini had a breakout season in 2016 and has continued that into 2017. He ranks ninth in D-II in receiving yards per game (110.7) and 11th in receptions per game (7.6). Contini had 97 yards in the opener at Cal, 156 yards at Ashland, and 95 yards at Penn. Against Lake Erie, he made 11 grabs for 121 yards and two scores. One of those receptions was featured on ESPN's Sunday NFL Countdown by Randy Moss.

Against Hillsdale, he caught nine passes for 161 yards and a TD, and he went for 110 yards and a TD at Alderson Broadus.

Contini now has at least 90 yards in 12 of his 23 career games played and has caught at least five passes in 13 games. This year, he has been targeted 63 times and caught 53 of those passes.

He picked up Second Team All-GLIAC honors in 2016 as he ranked fourth in the conference in receptions (69) and yards per game (89.5) while hauling in seven touchdowns. Fifty of his 69 receptions went for first down yardage, and he set career highs in receptions (11) and yards (171) at Northern Michigan. Contini's 984 yards were the fifth-most in ODU single-season history and his 69 catches were fifth.

ONE KOHL CUSTOMER

Middle linebacker Cameron Kohl has made at least nine tackles in four of the last six games and leads ODU with 55 stops on the season (6.5 tackles for loss). He finished with 13 tackles (2.5 TFL) at Ashland and 10 tackles at Penn. Kohl had a huge performance at Alderson Broaddus, making 12 tackles with two sacks.

He ranks tied fourth in the G-MAC in tackles per game (7.9), is fifth in tackles for loss, and sixth in sacks (3.0).

Kohl emerged as a difference maker late in the 2014 season. He made 35 of his 49 tackles during ODU's three-game postseason run, including 14 tackles, a forced fumble and an interception in the win at Ferris State.

In 2015, he earned Honorable Mention All-GLIAC accolades after totaling 66 tackles (8.5 TFL). In 2016, Kohl registered 56 tackles, including 10 at Ferris State.

RETURN OF THE MACK

Senior Tre McIntyre had his third career game of 10 or more tackles in week four as he registered 11 stops in the shutout win against Lake Erie. He was making his first start at safety after spending the last year and a half primarily as ODU's "star" linebacker.

McIntyre followed that by making eight tackles (1.5 TFL) at Malone and now has 45 tackles on the season. He picked off his first pass of the season in the win at Alderson Broaddus. McIntyre ranks 12th in the G-MAC with 6.4 tackles per game and four passes defended.

He stepped into a starting role in 2016 and shined. McIntyre entered 2016 with 25 career tackles in 19 games, and last year ranked fourth on the team in tackles (77) in 11 starts.

McIntyre ranked 17th in the GLIAC in solo tackles (41) and tied for fifth with four interceptions, the most of any linebacker. McIntyre picked off two passes in the fourth quarter at Findlay to help seal ODU's road victory, then clinched the win at SVSU with another fourth quarter pick.

HOP ON THE BUS GUS

Gus Dimmerling intercepted a pass at Penn, the second of his career, and also had one breakup. He had eight tackles in the game against Ashland and eight more with a pick at Malone. His 37 total stops are fourth-most on the team and he's tied for second in the G-MAC with two picks. He now has eight or more tackles in eighth career games.

He spent time at running back and receiver in 2016 spring practices and spent most of fall training camp as a backup quarterback. He switched to the defensive side of the ball before the 2016 opener and thrived as one of ODU's starting safeties.

In 2016, Dimmerling made 11 tackles in each of ODU's first two games against Ferris State and Findlay and also picked off a pass and broke up three others against the Oilers. He ranked 16th in the GLIAC with 80 total tackles and was seventh with eight pass break ups.

TURNER THE BURNER

David Turner had an impressive debut season in 2016 and has continued to excel in 2017. He ranks second in the G-MAC and 13th in the country with 7.3 catches per game, and his 100.9 yards per game are 18th in the nation and fourth in the conference. Turner's 157.0 all-purpose yards per game rank 20th in the country and second in the G-MAC.

Turner started the season with 101 yards and a score at Cal and 164 yards and two TDs at Ashland. He set an ODU record with 331 all-purpose yards at Ashland. Turner had another 100 yard performance at Malone with a 73 yard touchdown reception, and he had nine grabs for 150 yards and a 75 yard TD at Alderson Broaddus. That was tied for the seventh longest pass play in ODU history.

Turner worked his way into the starting lineup at receiver for the final six games in 2016. He finished with 32 catches for 359 yards, ranking third on the team in both categories. Turner broke loose against Walsh, hauling in 11 passes for 161 yards and two scores.

Turner was also a threat in the return game. He had a 100 yard kickoff return for a score against Northwood and averaged 25.6 yards per kick return, tops in the GLIAC and 39th nationally. The return for a touchdown was just the fourth in ODU history.

HOLD ME NOW

Redshirt junior Ross Thompson made 11 tackles (1.5 TFL) in the season-opener at Cal. He has been limited by injury this season, but still has 26 tackles on the season (3.0 TFL).

In 2016, Thompson blossomed as a second-year starter, leading the team and ranking 10th in the GLIAC with 94 tackles. That was the seventh-most tackles in ODU single-season history.

Thompson earned his first career GLIAC Player of the Week award after making 17 tackles (4.0 TFL) in the win over Wayne State. Those were the third-most tackles in a game in ODU history.

Thompson ranked 13th in the GLIAC with 10.0 tackles for loss. He made seven or more tackles in eight games, including 13 stops in the opener at Ferris State and 11 more against Northwood.

In 28 career games played, he has made 176 tackles (18.5 TFL).

BRIAN'S SONG

Brian Hunter has steadily improved during his three seasons at ODU. The junior defensive end ranks sixth on the team this fall with 35 tackles and leads the team with 6.0 tackles for loss, which is fourth in the G-MAC. His 4.0 sacks are fourth in the conference and pace the Panthers as well.

He had a huge game at Penn, making seven tackles (2.0 TFL) while forcing and recovering a fumble and also picking up a sack. He's made at least five tackles in each of his last five games and blocked a field goal against Lake Erie.

Hunter has now made 107 tackles (8.0 sacks) and 19.0 tackles for loss in his career. Last season, he finished with four sacks and 8.5 tackles for loss.

CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER

In his first season with the Panther program, sophomore Cedric Washington has proven to be a big play threat as he already has a pair of 100-yard receiving games. Washington racked up 137 yards and two touchdowns at Cal in the opener, with each covering 52 yards, and he tallied 107 yards at Penn.

Washington has nine receptions of 20 yards or longer, including three against Hillsdale, and is averaging a team-best 17.1 yards per reception. His 70.7 yards per game rank fifth in the G-MAC and 73rd in the country.

As a freshman at Lindsey Wilson last year, Washington was named the Mid-South Conference Offensive Freshman of the Year after he tallied 772 yards on 35 catches, averaging 22.1 yards per catch with seven TDs. He had a trio of 100 yard games.

TOTAL ECLIPSE OF THE HARDT

Freshman Logen Neidhardt won the punting job in fall camp and has excelled, earning G-MAC Special Teams Player of the Week in consecutive weeks.

Against Malone, Neidhardt placed three of his six punts inside the 20 at Malone and averaged 39.5 yards per punt, earning the honor for the first time. Against Lake Erie, he averaged 41.7 yards per punt. His first one carried 45 yards and was downed at the one, leading to a safety. Two of his three punts were placed inside the 20 as he picked up the honor again. He was the first true punter in ODU's Division II era to earn a conference player of the week award.

Neidhardt was even better against Penn in week three, averaging 46.0 yards per punt on seven boots, with six of them carrying at least 40 yards and a long of 54 yards.

He ranks 32nd in the country in punting average (40.7). He has placed nine of his 32 punts inside the 20 and forced five fair catches with no touchbacks.

RUN COLSON RUN

In three of the last four games, EJ Colson has put up big numbers out of the backfield. Against Lake Erie, he had 72 yards on just five carries, and followed that with a 150 yard effort on 12 runs at Malone.

At Alderson Broaddus, Colson went off for a career-high 153 yards on 17 carries and scored four touchdowns, picking up G-MAC Player of the Week honors. Colson has now averaged at least 7.0 yards per carry in each of the last four games.

He had an 85 yard run at Malone, tied for the second longest in school history, and his four TDs at AB are tied for second-most in a game in ODU history. His 12.5 yards per carry at Malone are third-most in a game in ODU history and his 9.0 yards per carry at AB are tied for eighth-most.

Colson's 6.9 yards per carry are third-best in the G-MAC and he's sixth in the conference with 458 rushing yards.

NOT SHYING AWAY

Shyoun Petteway was inserted into the starting lineup in week four against Lake Erie and responded, making an interception in each of his first three starts. He was named the G-MAC Defensive Player of the Week after his performance against Hillsdale, making 15 tackles, picking off a pass and recovering a fumble.

Petteway had nine tackles and a pick against Lake Erie and finished with 10 tackles, an interception and three pass break ups at Malone.

He ranks third on the team with 44 tackles and ranks second in the league with eight passes defended. His three interceptions are tied for tops in the league.
