#### FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME

This will be just the second game in the series between the two teams. Walsh traveled down to Owensboro back in 2012 for its first game as an NCAA Division II member. In that game, the Cavaliers overcame a Panthers' touchdown early in the second quarter to score 40 unanswered points en route to a 40-10 win.

#### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

This will be the last long road trip of the season for the Cavaliers and the fourth in the past five weeks after a season-opening home game against Wayne State. The Cavaliers will close out the season with three of their final five games at Tom Benson Stadium.

#### **NEW COACH**

Dan Pifer will lead the Cavaliers for the 2017 campaign. He is just the third head coach and program history. He comes to North Canton after five years at Division III Olivet College in Michigan. There he led the Comets to a 30-21 record with winning seasons in each of the last four years, including two conference championships in each of the past two seasons.

#### **NEW CONFERENCE**

Continuing with the trend, Walsh is now a full member of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. While it is a new conference, many familiar faces will still appear on the football schedule. Also making the transition from the GLIAC are Findlay, Hillsdale, Lake Erie, and Ohio Dominican. Long time rivals Malone made the jump last season. New conference foes for the Cavs include Alderson Broaddus (W.Va.) and Kentucky Wesleyan.

#### **NEW DIGS**

Walsh once again calls Tom Benson Stadium its home after playing the 2016 season at North Canton Memorial Stadium. Walsh has played at the Hall of Fame since the 1997 season. Last season Tom Benson Stadium was completely renovated.

#### **BIG PLAY ABILITY**

Of the 10 longest runs in the G-MAC this year, Walsh is responsible for three of them. Findlay is the only other team listed three times. Kalvin Gordon made two of the three with a 65-yard scamper at Central Connecticut State and a 50-yard burst last week against Findlay to set up a field goal. Gordon also has the third-longest reception in the conference this season with a 76-yard reception at Jacksonville.

#### **KICKING WITH KASEY**

After last week's 43-yard field goal, Kasey Tingler now has three of the five longest field goals in the conference, including the two longest. His 44-yarder at Jacksonville is the longest in the G-MAC this season.

#### **DISCIPLINED**

Walsh continues to be one of the best disciplined teams in the conference with an average of 45.8 penalty yards per game. Hillsdale leads the conference with 38.2 penalty yards per game. Walsh has had 25 flags thrown against them, second behind Hillsdale (20/5 games).

#### **COMPARING THE OFFENSE**

Kentucky Wesleyan has scored two more touchdowns on the season, but Walsh's attack is more balanced than the Panthers. The Cavaliers have scored just one more touchdown on the ground than by through the air. However, all of Kentucky Wesleyan's touchdowns have been on passing plays.

### **HEAD COACH DAN PIFER**



Walsh University Vice President and Director of Athletics Dale Howard has named Dan Pifer as the new head coach of the Cavalier football team. Pifer, a native of Celina, Ohio, joins Walsh from Olivet College.

Pifer's primary focus will be to tap into the rich history of football in the area. Through his coaching experience and the college teams he has competed against regionally, Pifer is no stranger to the abundance of talent in Northeast Ohio.

"I think this place is a gold mine," said Coach Pifer. "It will be a brand new start with a new league with a lot of schools that are similar in mind set. My priority is to recruit locally within the state of Ohio with a special emphasis on Northeast Ohio as there are plenty of good kids and strong players within our local community. It will also be a great opportunity to get back to the Division II level and be involved with scholarships again."

"In Dan Pifer, we have hired a successful coach with a track record of building football programs by instilling player self-esteem and motivation," added Athletic Director Dale Howard. "Dan espouses the philosophy that winning begins with building relationships and trust with the coaching staff, players, parents, fans, and alumni. His enthusiasm to develop student-athletes both on and off the field of play makes him a great fit with Walsh University and our mission of developing the total student in mind, body and spirit."

This past season, Pifer guided the Comets to a 9-2 record with an appearance in the NCAA Division III Playoffs. Olivet went a perfect 6-0 in the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) to win the conference championship and tie a program record for wins in a season.

Pifer led the Comets for five seasons as the head coach and quickly turned around the program into a power in the MIAA. After going 0-10 in his first season, he led Olivet to a 6-4 season the next two years. In 2015, Pifer led his team to a 9-1 record to set the new school record for wins in a season, were co-champions of the MIAA with a 5-1 record.

Prior to joining Olivet, Pifer was the offensive coordinator, recruiting coordinator, and special teams coordinator at Trine (Ind.) University for six seasons. While there, he helped guide the Thunder into a national power with three NCAA Division III playoff appearances from 2008 to 2010. This included three-straight conference championships with undefeated MIAA seasons. Trine went 41-7 during that time and won 20-straight games both at home and within the MIAA.

Pifer coached Eric Watt, who won the 2010 NCAA Division III Gagliardi Trophy for being the nation's player of the year. That season, Trine led the nation in Division III in scoring offense at 47 points per game.

Pifer has also coached at Bellmont High School for four years, Hillsdale College for two years, University of St. Francis (Ind.) for three years, and St. Joseph's (Ind.) College for one year.

He earned his bachelor's degree in political science from California University of Pennsylvania in 1995 where he was a quarterback for the Vulcans.
