SERIES HISTORY

This will be the first meeting between Walsh and Alderson Broaddus. The Battlers are a relatively new program that initially started in 2012.

GROUND AND POUND

The Cavaliers had one of their best games in program history rushing for 408 yards and seven touchdowns in the win against Kentucky Wesleyan. The record for most in a single game is 471 yards and eight touchdowns. The yards mark was set in 2000 against Urbana while the touchdown record was set in 2009 against Olivet Nazarene.

ADD 'EM UP

Walsh scored 28 points in the second quarter to take control of the game in the 56-29 victory over the Panthers. The 56 points is the most Walsh has scored in a game since 2011 and the most since joining Division II. The Cavs' previous record for points in Division II was 45 in a win against Tiffin in 2014. Walsh scored 60 in a shutout of Concordia in 2011, and the record for points in a game is 63 against Kentucky Christian in 2010.

NEW COACH

Dan Pifer will lead the Cavaliers for the 2017 campaign. He is just the third head coach and program history. He comes to North Canton after five years at Division III Olivet College in Michigan and led the Comets winning seasons in each of the last four years, including two conference championships the past two years.

NEW CONFERENCE, NEW DIGS

Continuing with the trend, Walsh is now a full member of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. While it is a new conference, many familiar faces will still appear on the football schedule. Also making the transition from the GLIAC are Findlay, Hillsdale, Lake Erie, and Ohio Dominican. Long time rivals Malone made the jump last season. New conference foes for the Cavs include Alderson Broaddus (W.Va.) and Kentucky Wesleyan. Walsh once again calls Tom Benson Stadium its home after playing the 2016 season at North Canton Memorial Stadium. Walsh has played at the Hall of Fame since the 1997 season. Last season Tom Benson Stadium was completely renovated.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Walsh had its first G-MAC Player of the Week in football as Leondre Crosby earned the honors on special teams. Crosby blocked a punt that was recovered and returned for a touchdown at the end of the second quarter to give Walsh four touchdowns in the period. Earlier in the quarter, he returned a fumble 71 yards to set up Walsh for a touchdown one play later.

FIRST DOWNS

The Cavaliers recorded 28 first downs last week against Kentucky Wesleyan, a season high and fourth-most in a single game by any G-MAC team in a game this year. Nine of them came by rushing, which is the most by a G-MAC team in a game this year.

THE LONGEST YARD

Mitchell Ault connected with Deondre Cook for an 85-yard pass last week, which gives Walsh the longest pass of the year in the G-MAC once again. Malone also has a pass of 85 yards recorded on September 23. Walsh now has two of the top four longest passes in the G-MAC this year. The other was a 76-yard pass at Jacksonville on September 16.

GARVE 'EM UP

Dylan Garver is currently fifth in the G-MAC with 8.3 yackles per game. He has 22 solo tackles and 28 assists for a total of 50, second-most in the G-MAC.

HEAD COACH DAN PIFER



Walsh University Vice President and Director of Athletics Dale Howard has named Dan Pifer as the new head coach of the Cavalier football team. Pifer, a native of Celina, Ohio, joins Walsh from Olivet College.

Pifer's primary focus will be to tap into the rich history of football in the area. Through his coaching experience and the college teams he has competed against regionally, Pifer is no stranger to the abundance of talent in Northeast Ohio.

"I think this place is a gold mine," said Coach Pifer. "It will be a brand new start with a new league with a lot of schools that are similar in mind set. My priority is to recruit locally within the state of Ohio with a special emphasis on Northeast Ohio as there are plenty of good kids and strong players within our local community. It will also be a great opportunity to get back to the Division II level and be involved with scholarships again."

"In Dan Pifer, we have hired a successful coach with a track record of building football programs by instilling player self-esteem and motivation," added Athletic Director Dale Howard. "Dan espouses the philosophy that winning begins with building relationships and trust with the coaching staff, players, parents, fans, and alumni. His enthusiasm to develop student-athletes both on and off the field of play makes him a great fit with Walsh University and our mission of developing the total student in mind, body and spirit."

This past season, Pifer guided the Comets to a 9-2 record with an appearance in the NCAA Division III Playoffs. Olivet went a perfect 6-0 in the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) to win the conference championship and tie a program record for wins in a season.

Pifer led the Comets for five seasons as the head coach and quickly turned around the program into a power in the MIAA. After going 0-10 in his first season, he led Olivet to a 6-4 season the next two years. In 2015, Pifer led his team to a 9-1 record to set the new school record for wins in a season, were co-champions of the MIAA with a 5-1 record.

Prior to joining Olivet, Pifer was the offensive coordinator, recruiting coordinator, and special teams coordinator at Trine (Ind.) University for six seasons. While there, he helped guide the Thunder into a national power with three NCAA Division III playoff appearances from 2008 to 2010. This included three-straight conference championships with undefeated MIAA seasons. Trine went 41-7 during that time and won 20-straight games both at home and within the MIAA.

Pifer coached Eric Watt, who won the 2010 NCAA Division III Gagliardi Trophy for being the nation's player of the year. That season, Trine led the nation in Division III in scoring offense at 47 points per game.

Pifer has also coached at Belmont High School for four years, Hillsdale College for two years, University of St. Francis (Ind.) for three years, and St. Joseph's (Ind.) College for one year.

He earned his bachelor's degree in political science from California University of Pennsylvania in 1995 where he was a quarterback for the Vulcans.
