SERIES HISTORY

Walsh and Ohio Dominican have met quite a few times over the years with the Panthers leading the all-time series 7-4. The 11 games are the most against any other team on the schedule in program history other than Malone. ODU has won the last five games in the series that has been played yearly since 2012. The Cavaliers last win in the series came in 2009 when Walsh upset the nationally ranked Panthers 23-16. The series started in 2004 with a 41-0 Walsh win over Ohio Dominican.

STAYING LOCAL

This is technically the last home game for the Cavaliers, but Walsh won't have to travel much the rest of the season. Next week's trip to Lake Erie will be the shortest road trip of the season up to this point at 1.5 hours. The following week against Malone will also be at Tom Benson Stadium, but it will be a home game for the Pioneers.

RUNNING AROUND

Walsh is one of the top rushing teams in the conference with an average of 174.6 yards per game on the ground. Only Findlay has a better mark with 287.5 yards per game. It's been an attack by committee for the Cavaliers who have scored 14 rushing touchdowns with five players scoring multiple times. The team's leading rusher is Calvin Gordon who has 499 yards. Antwand Wilson leads the team with four touchdowns, while Koby Adu-Poku and Paris Salas have three touchdowns each. Deondre Cook has also ran two in despite being a wide receiver.

NEW CONFERENCE, NEW DIGS

Continuing with the trend, Walsh is now a full member of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. While it is a new conference, many familiar faces will still appear on the football schedule. Also making the transition from the GLIAC are Findlay, Hillsdale, Lake Erie, and Ohio Dominican. Long time rivals Malone made the jump last season. New conference foes for the Cavs include Alderson Broaddus (W.Va.) and Kentucky Wesleyan. Walsh once again calls Tom Benson Stadium its home after playing the 2016 season at North Canton Memorial Stadium. Walsh has played at the Hall of Fame since the 1997 season. Last season Tom Benson Stadium was completely renovated.

TOP OF TIME OF POSSESSION

Walsh is second in the conference in time of possession at an average of 32:51 per game. Only Findlay has a better TOP average at 33:50. Lake Erie is third behind the Cavaliers at 31:22.

SPECIAL AT SPECIAL TEAMS

Special teams has been a bright spot for the Cavaliers this season with two G-MAC Special Teams Players of the Week selections and longest plays. Koby Adu-Poku and Leondre Crosby both were named Players of the Week this season. Kasey Tingler also has three of the longest five field goals made this season, including the two longest at 44 and 43 yards.

Cole Krumpak also has three of the top five longest punts including the two longest at 70 and 65 yards. The Cavaliers have also done well at blocking kicks. Walsh has blocked four this season including two last week at Hillsdale. Adu-Poku also has the longest kick return this season at 93 yards in the win against Alderson Broaddus.

FINDING THE BALL

Dylan Garver and Nick Sturgill are amongst the best in the G-MAC in tackling. Garver is sixth in the conference with 62 tackles for 7.8 tackles per game. Sturgill is just outside the top 10 at No. 11 with 53 tackles and 6.6 per game.

HEAD COACH DAN PIFER



Walsh University Vice President and Director of Athletics Dale Howard has named Dan Pifer as the new head coach of the Cavalier football team. Pifer, a native of Celina, Ohio, joins Walsh from Olivet College.

Pifer's primary focus will be to tap into the rich history of football in the area. Through his coaching experience and the college teams he has competed against regionally, Pifer is no stranger to the abundance of talent in Northeast Ohio.

"I think this place is a gold mine," said Coach Pifer. "It will be a brand new start with a new league with a lot of schools that are similar in mind set. My priority is to recruit locally within the state of Ohio with a special emphasis on Northeast Ohio as there are plenty of good kids and strong players within our local community. It will also be a great opportunity to get back to the Division II level and be involved with scholarships again."

"In Dan Pifer, we have hired a successful coach with a track record of building football programs by instilling player self-esteem and motivation," added Athletic Director Dale Howard. "Dan espouses the philosophy that winning begins with building relationships and trust with the coaching staff, players, parents, fans, and alumni. His enthusiasm to develop student-athletes both on and off the field of play makes him a great fit with Walsh University and our mission of developing the total student in mind, body and spirit."

This past season, Pifer guided the Comets to a 9-2 record with an appearance in the NCAA Division III Playoffs. Olivet went a perfect 6-0 in the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) to win the conference championship and tie a program record for wins in a season.

Pifer led the Comets for five seasons as the head coach and quickly turned around the program into a power in the MIAA. After going 0-10 in his first season, he led Olivet to a 6-4 season the next two years. In 2015, Pifer led his team to a 9-1 record to set the new school record for wins in a season, were co-champions of the MIAA with a 5-1 record.

Prior to joining Olivet, Pifer was the offensive coordinator, recruiting coordinator, and special teams coordinator at Trine (Ind.) University for six seasons. While there, he helped guide the Thunder into a national power with three NCAA Division III playoff appearances from 2008 to 2010. This included three-straight conference championships with undefeated MIAA seasons. Trine went 41-7 during that time and won 20-straight games both at home and within the MIAA.

Pifer coached Eric Watt, who won the 2010 NCAA Division III Gagliardi Trophy for being the nation's player of the year. That season, Trine led the nation in Division III in scoring offense at 47 points per game.

Pifer has also coached at Belmont High School for four years, Hillsdale College for two years, University of St. Francis (Ind.) for three years, and St. Joseph's (Ind.) College for one year.

He earned his bachelor's degree in political science from California University of Pennsylvania in 1995 where he was a quarterback for the Vulcans.
